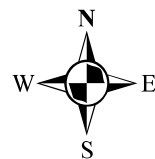
Geographic Township of HOUGHTON

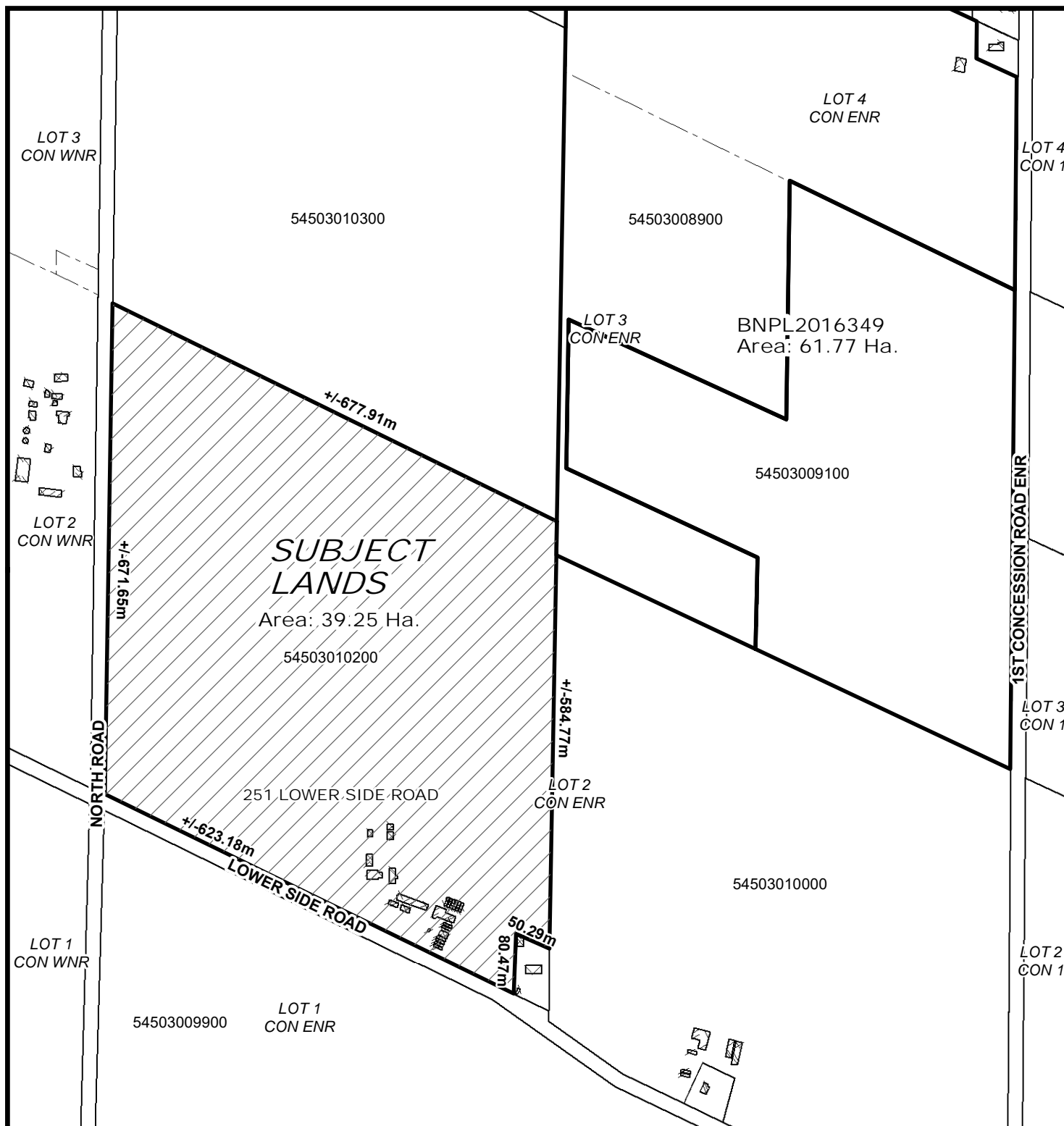

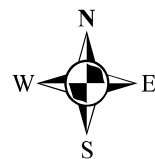
