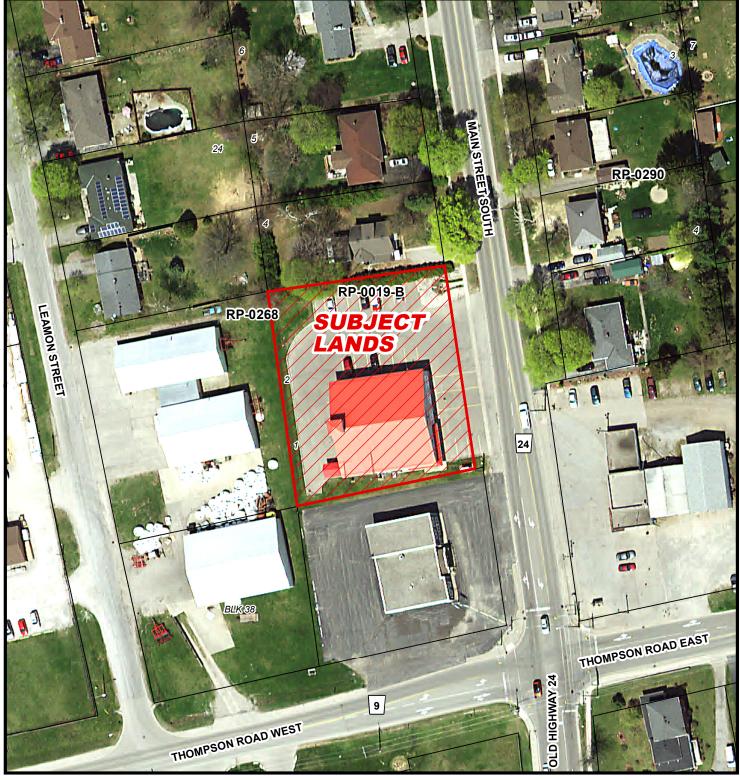




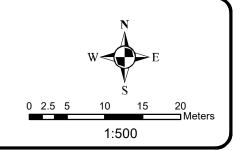


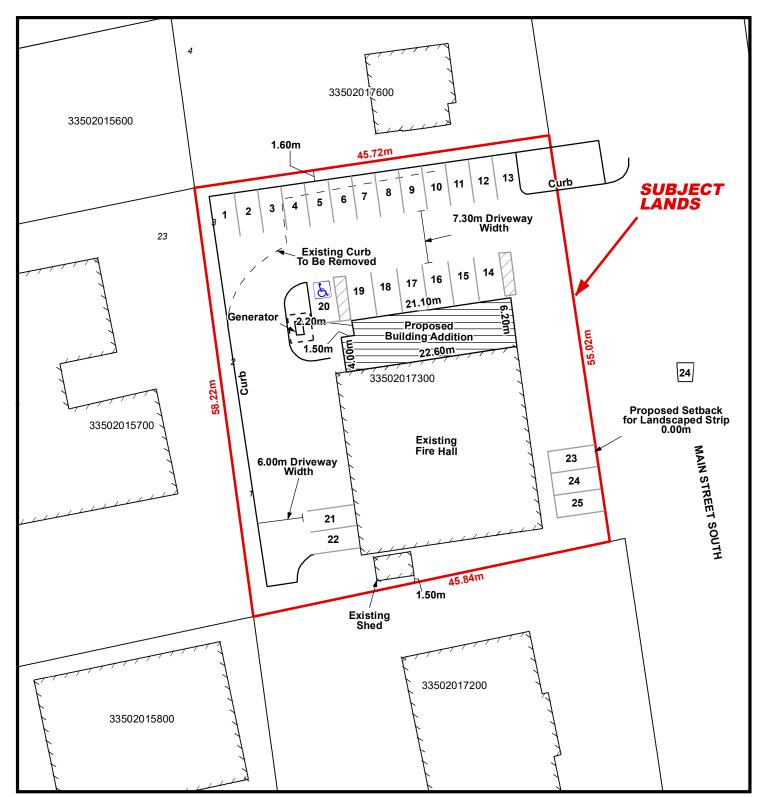
MAP 2 File Number: ANPL2019033 Urban Area of WATERFORD
