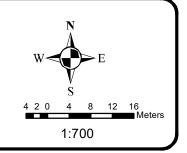

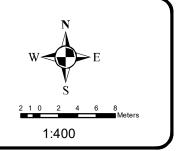


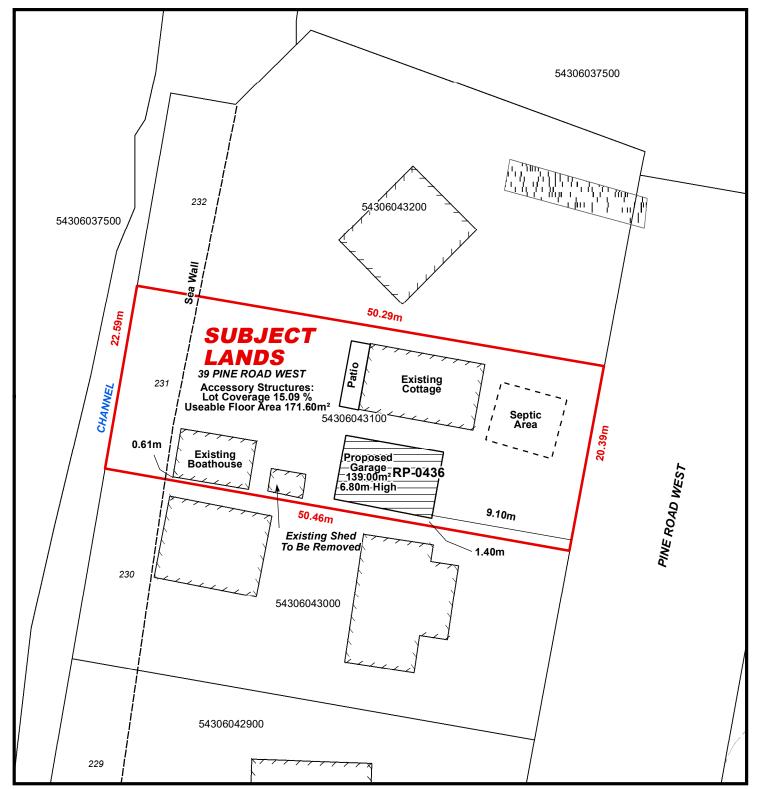
MAP 2
