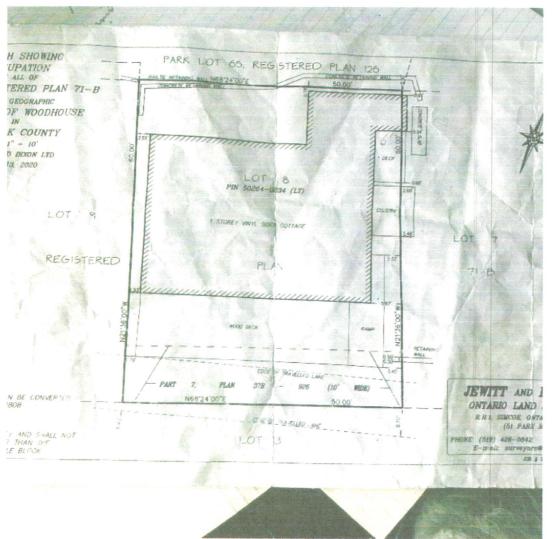

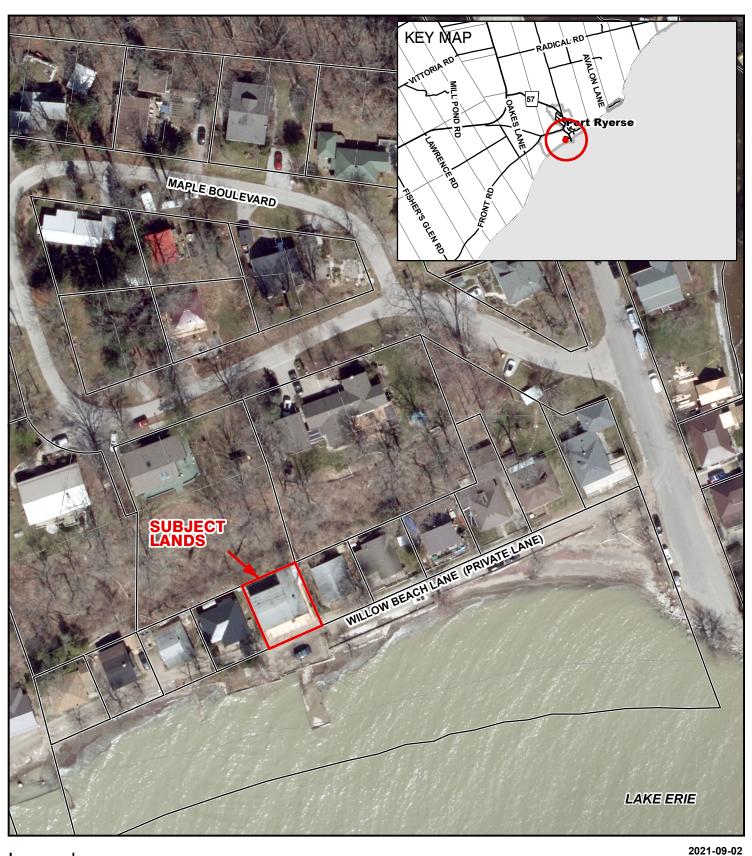

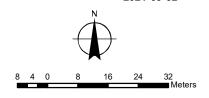
CONTEXT MAP

Geographic Township of WOODHOUSE



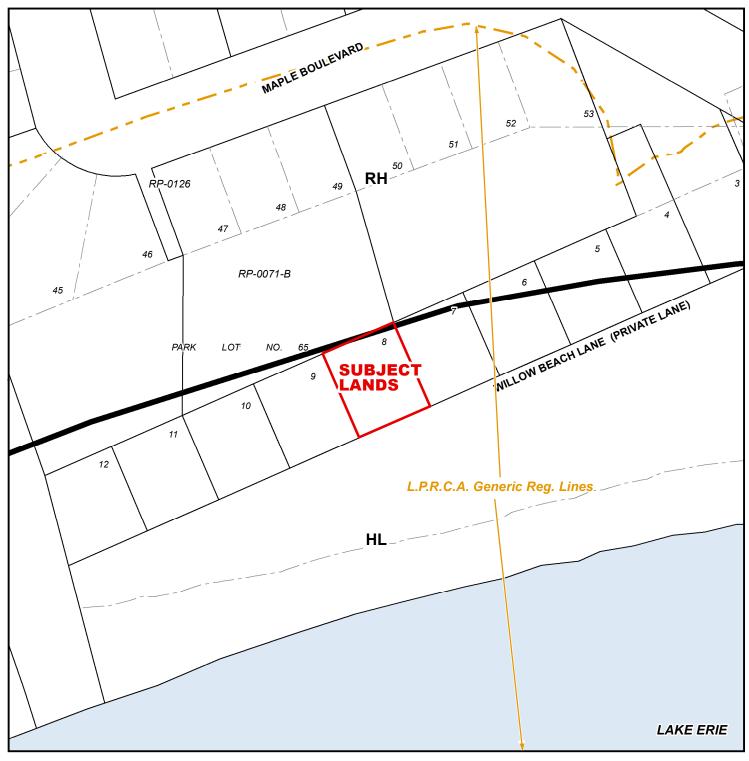

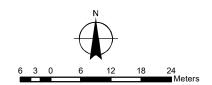
