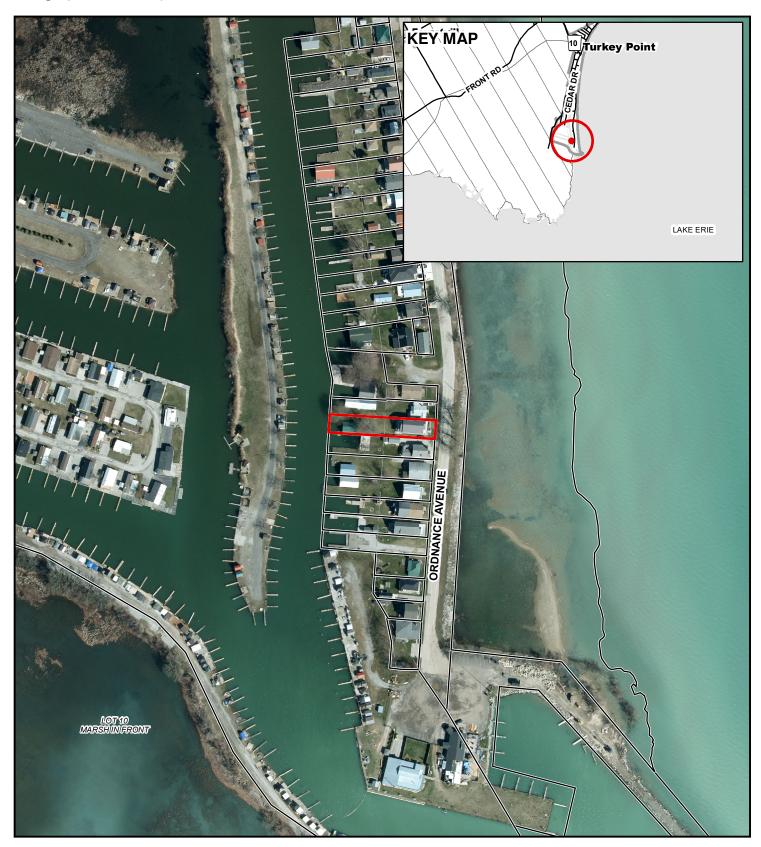






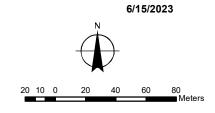
CONTEXT MAP

Geographic Township of CHARLOTTEVILLE



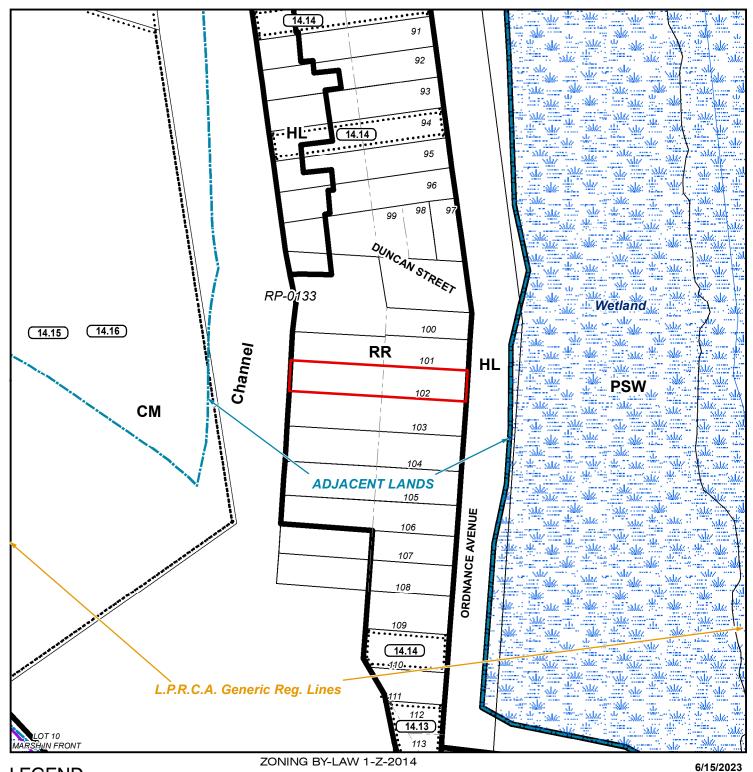

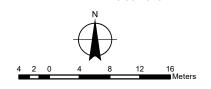
CONCEPTUAL PLAN

Geographic Township of CHARLOTTEVILLE



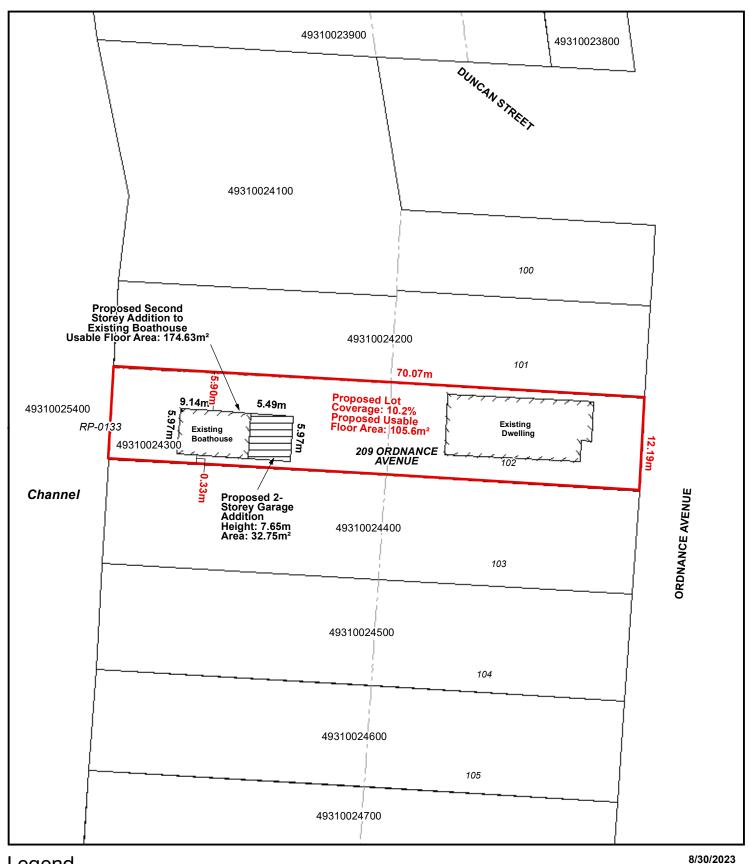
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CONCEPTUAL PLAN
