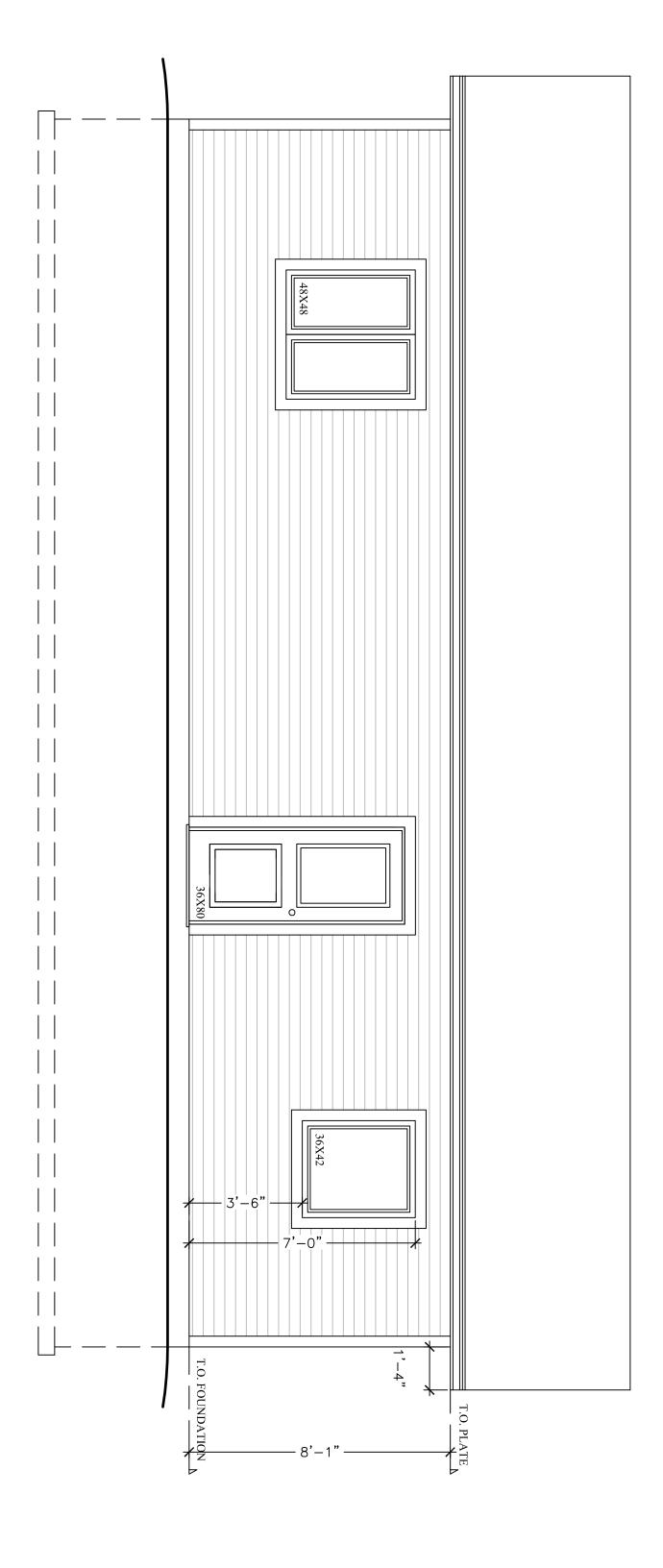


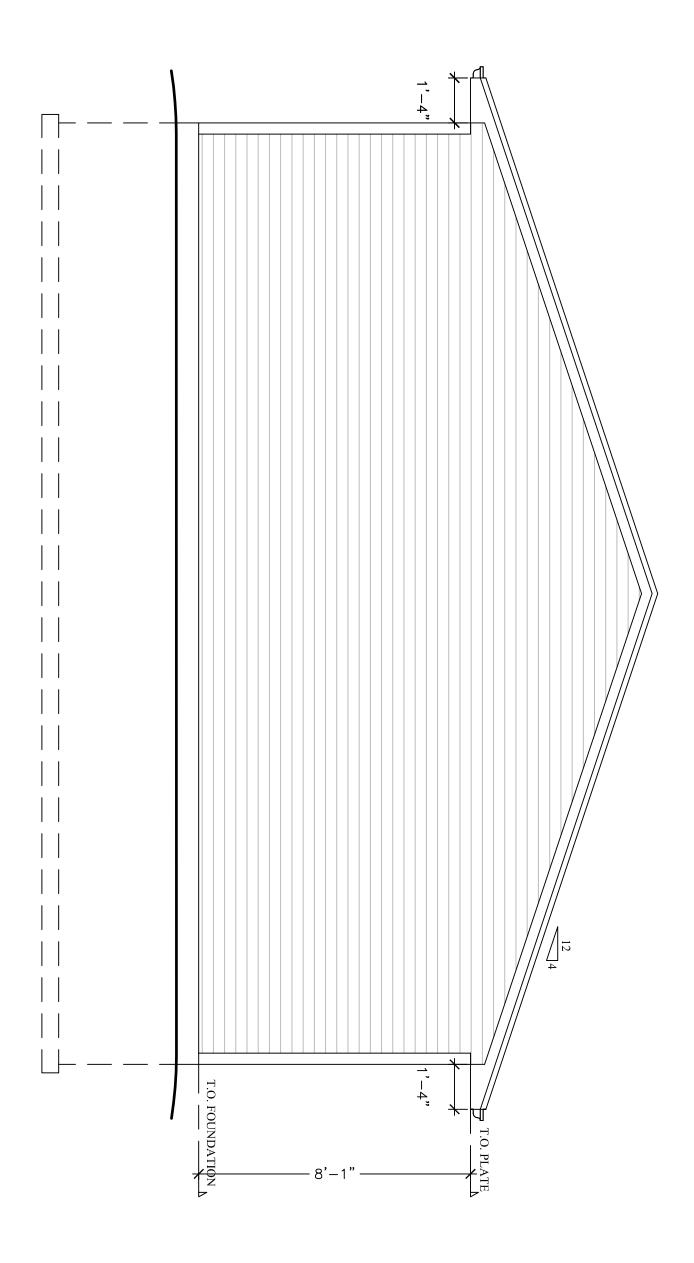


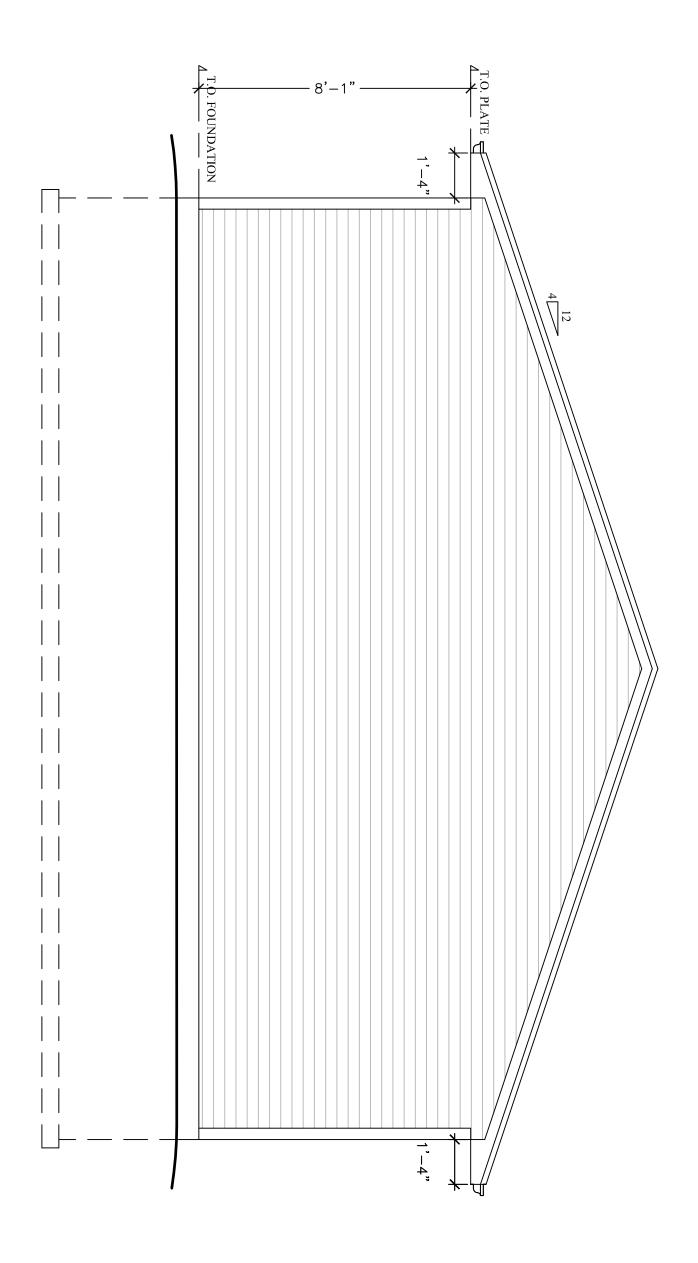


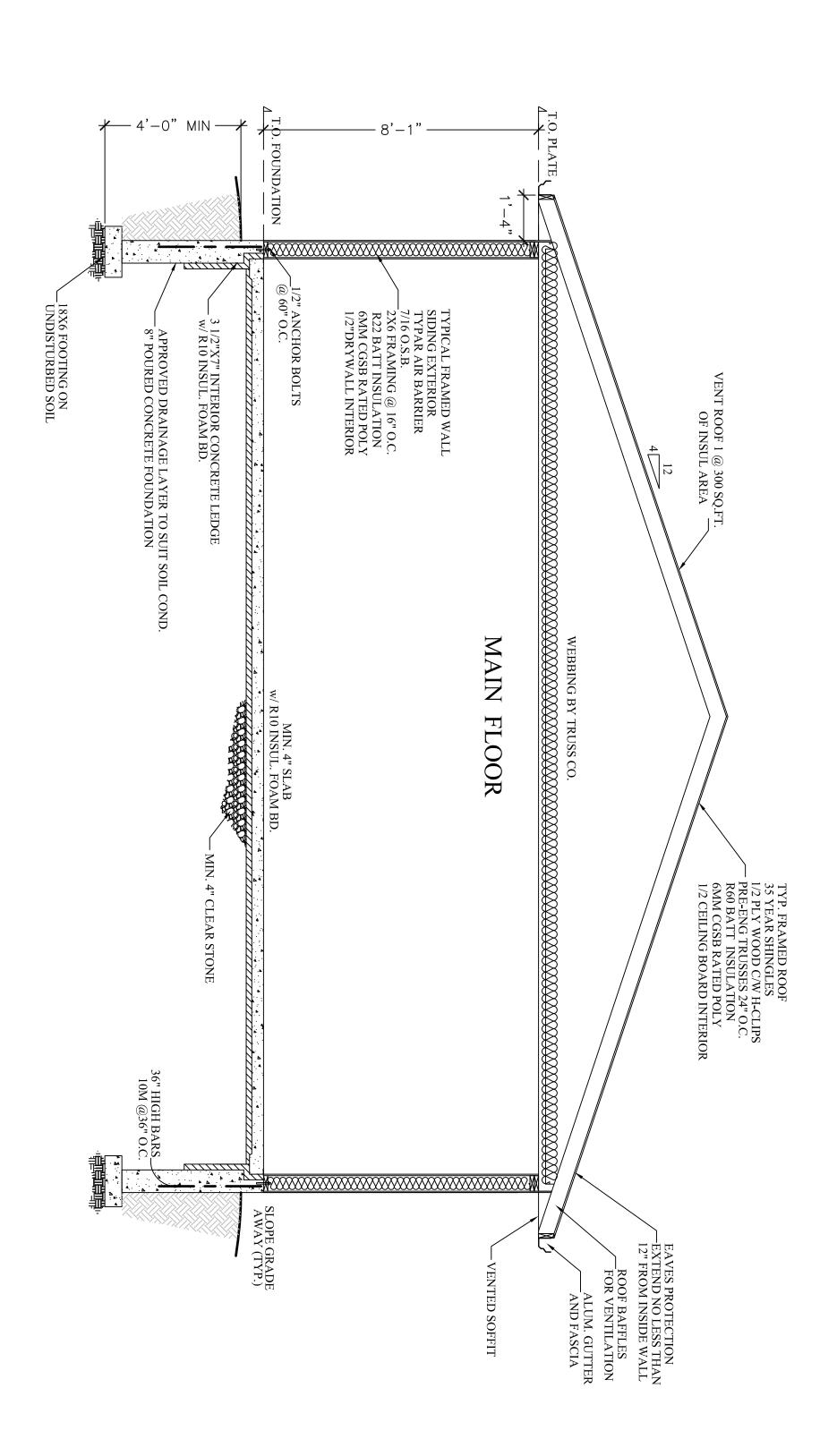






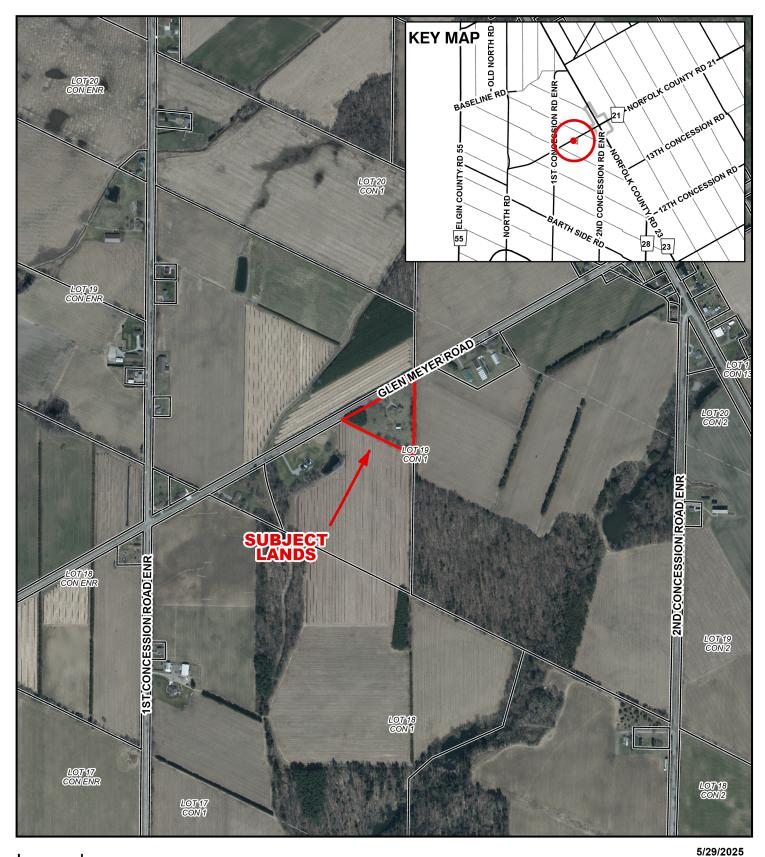




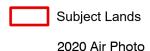


CONTEXT MAP

Geographic Township of HOUGHTON

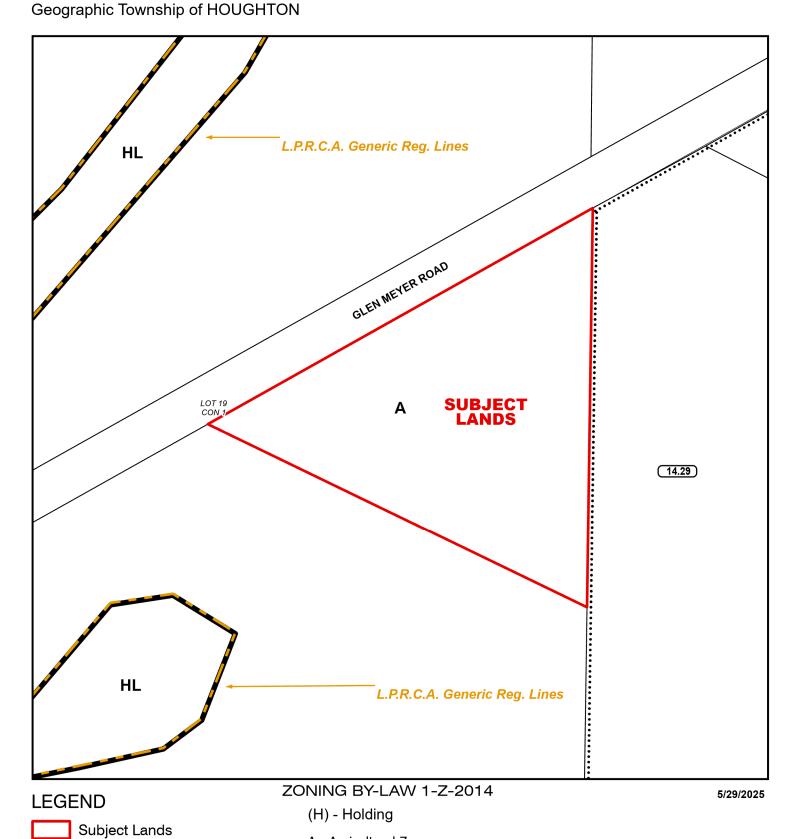


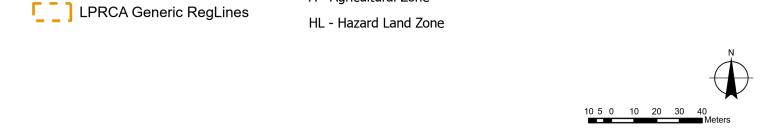
