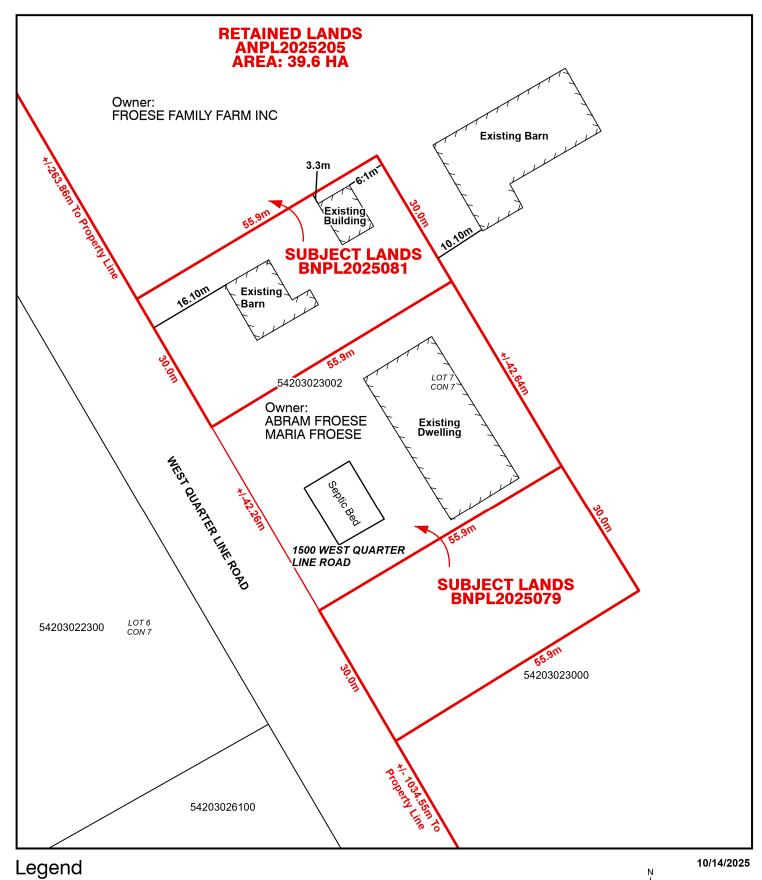


LOCATION OF LANDS AFFECTED
