- 5. That the solicitor acting in the transfer provide his undertaking in the following manner: in consideration of the Certificate by the Official I undertake to ensure by a subsearch of the abstract book that at the time of the registration of the said Certificate or deed upon which it has been affixed, the name of the registered owner of the abutting land is the same as that of the Grantee in the said deed.
- That the above conditions must be fulfilled and the Document for Conveyance (in triplicate) be 6. presented for stamping on or before November 2, 2000 after which time this consent will lapse.
