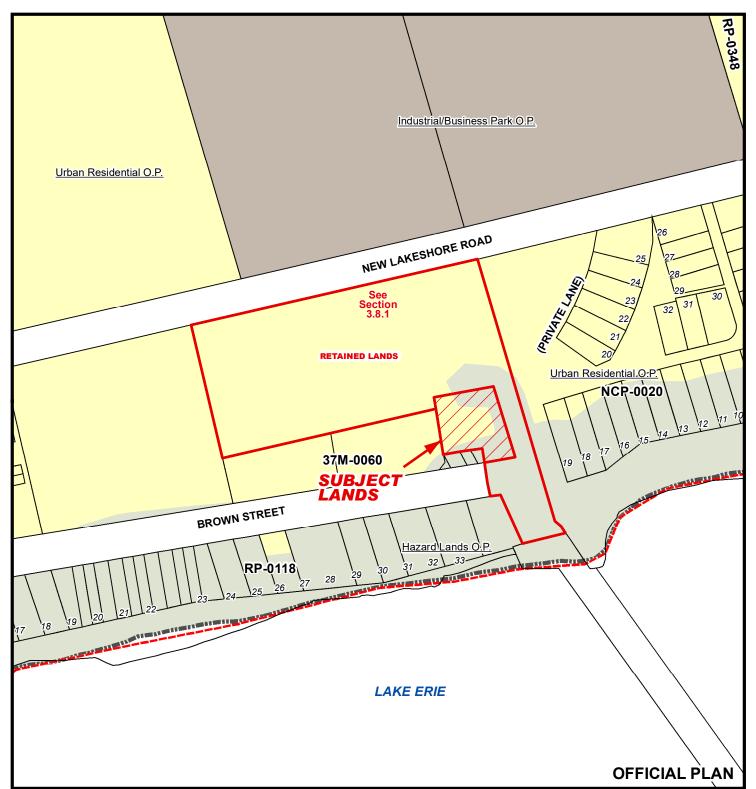

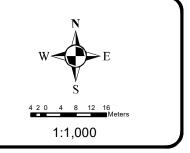

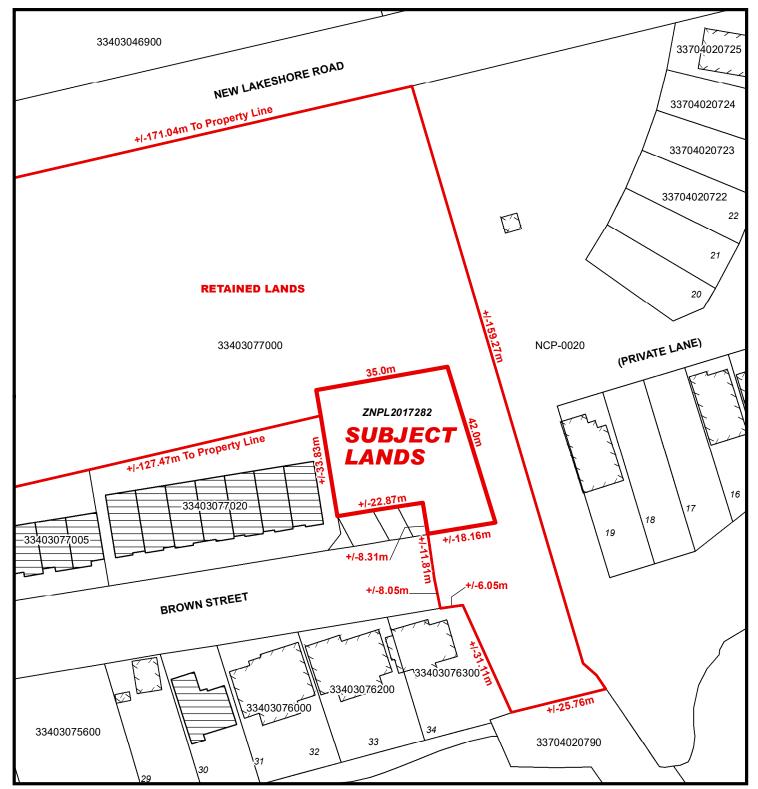




MAP 4
