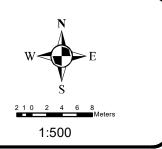


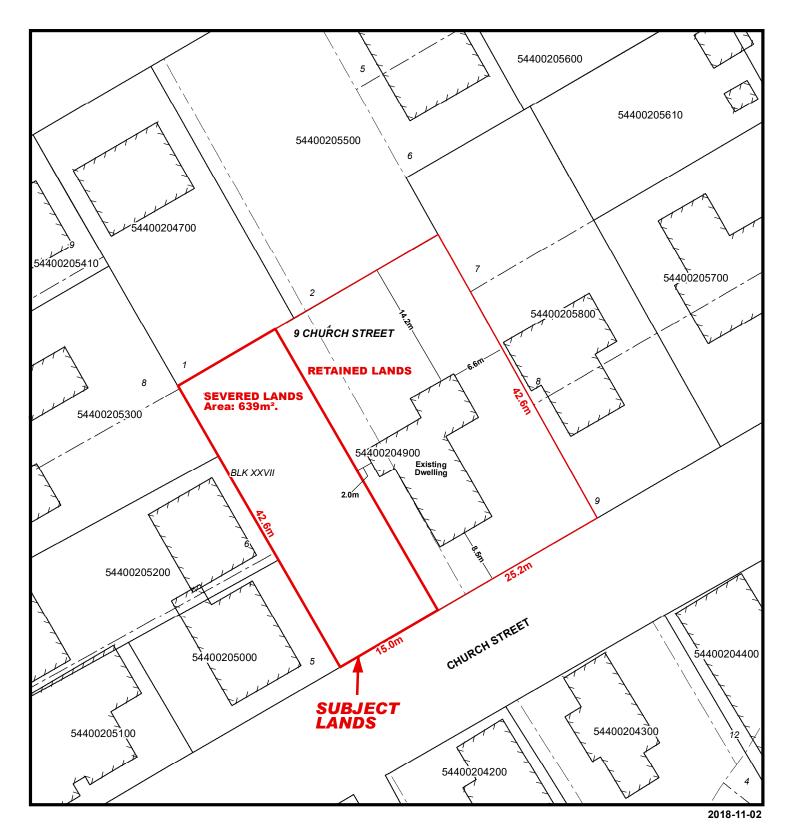


MAP 4
