MAP 3 File Number: BNPL2021047 Geographic Township of HOUGHTON

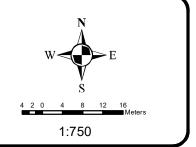


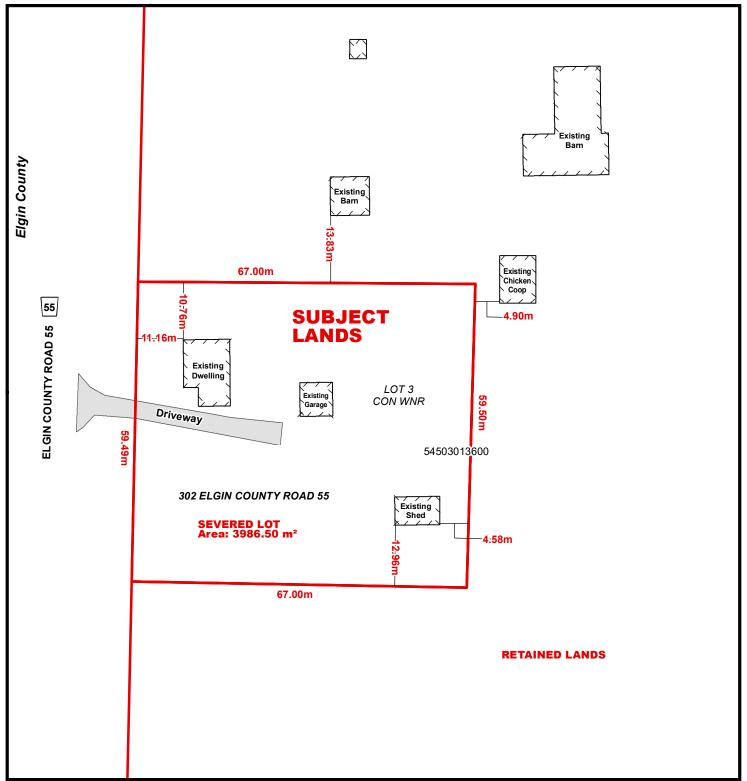


MAP 4
