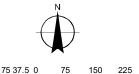

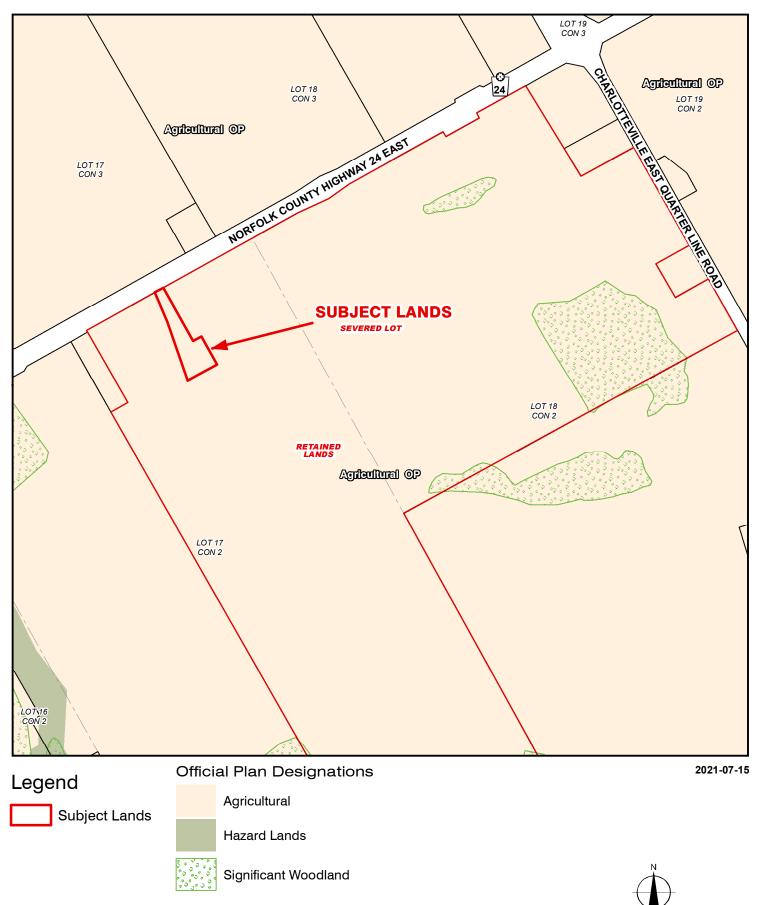

MAP C ZONING BY-LAW MAP Geographic Township of CHARLOTTEVILLE

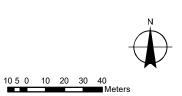

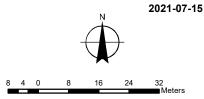


CONCEPTUAL PLAN
