

MAP NORFOLK - Community Web Map




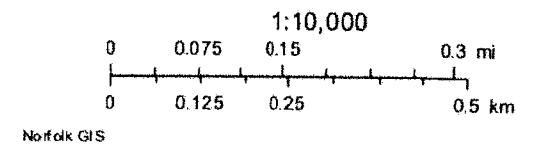

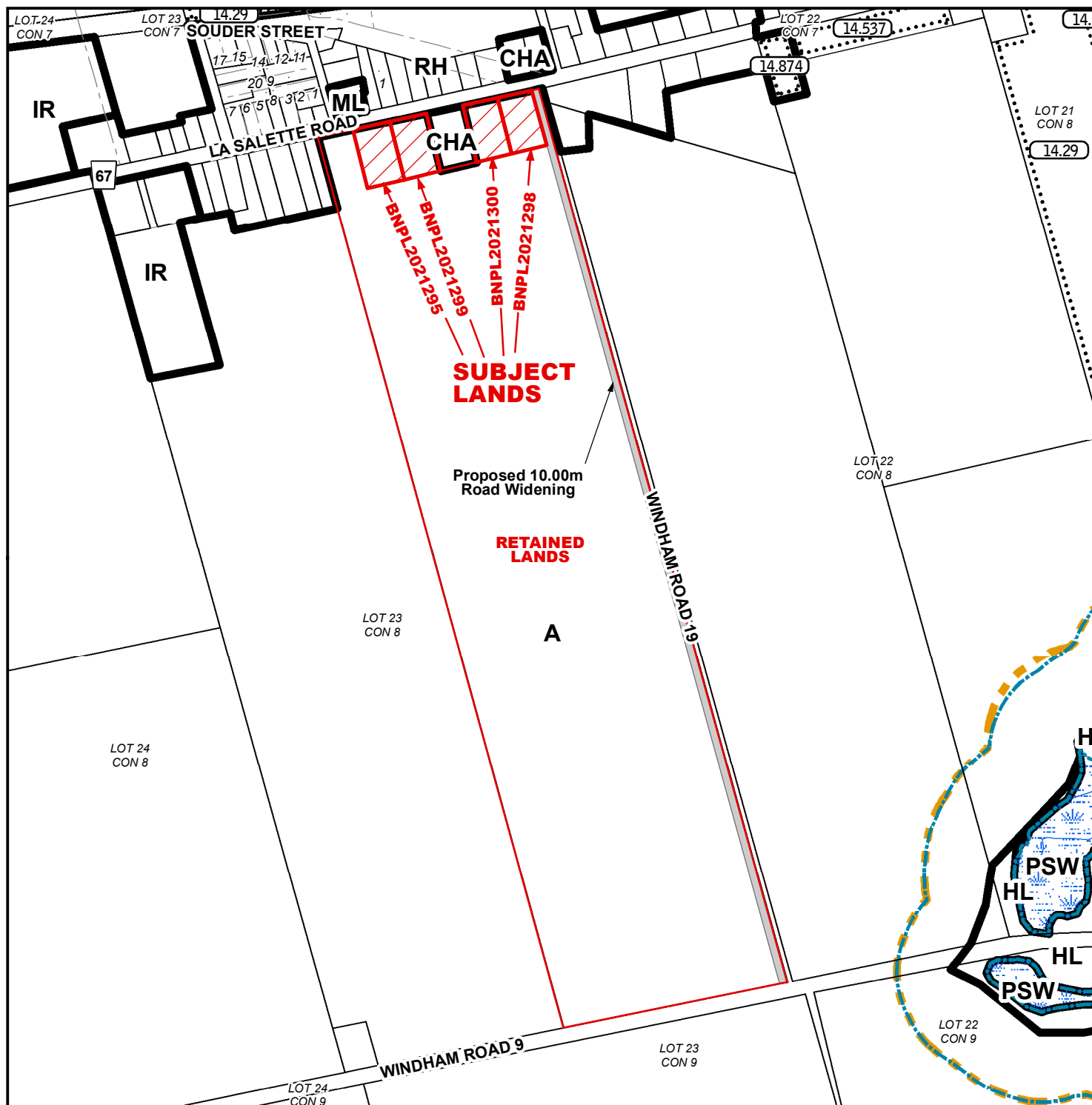


MAP C

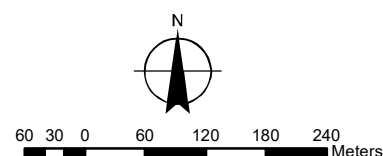

CONCEPTUAL PLAN

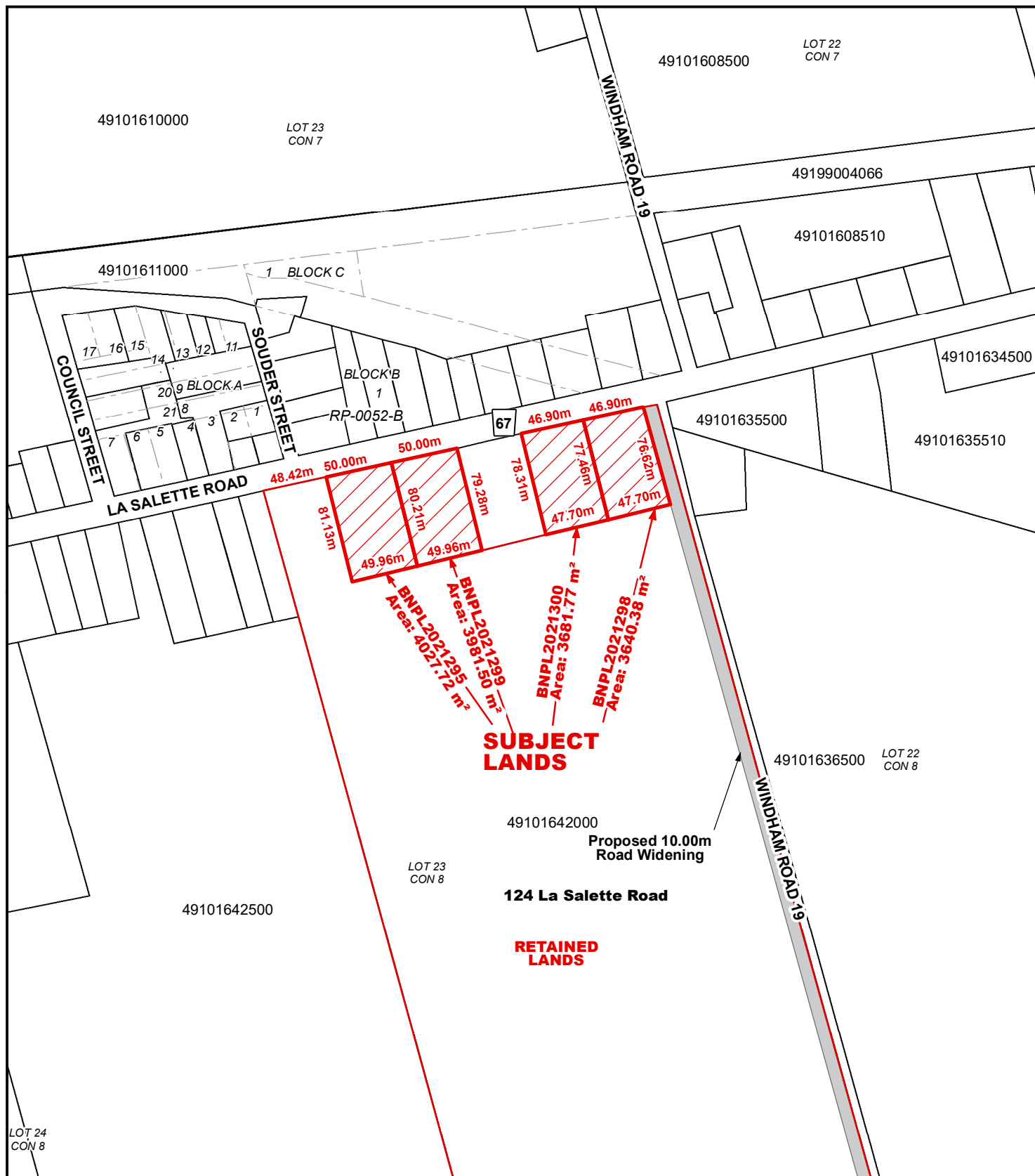

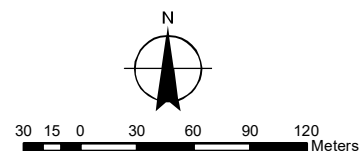

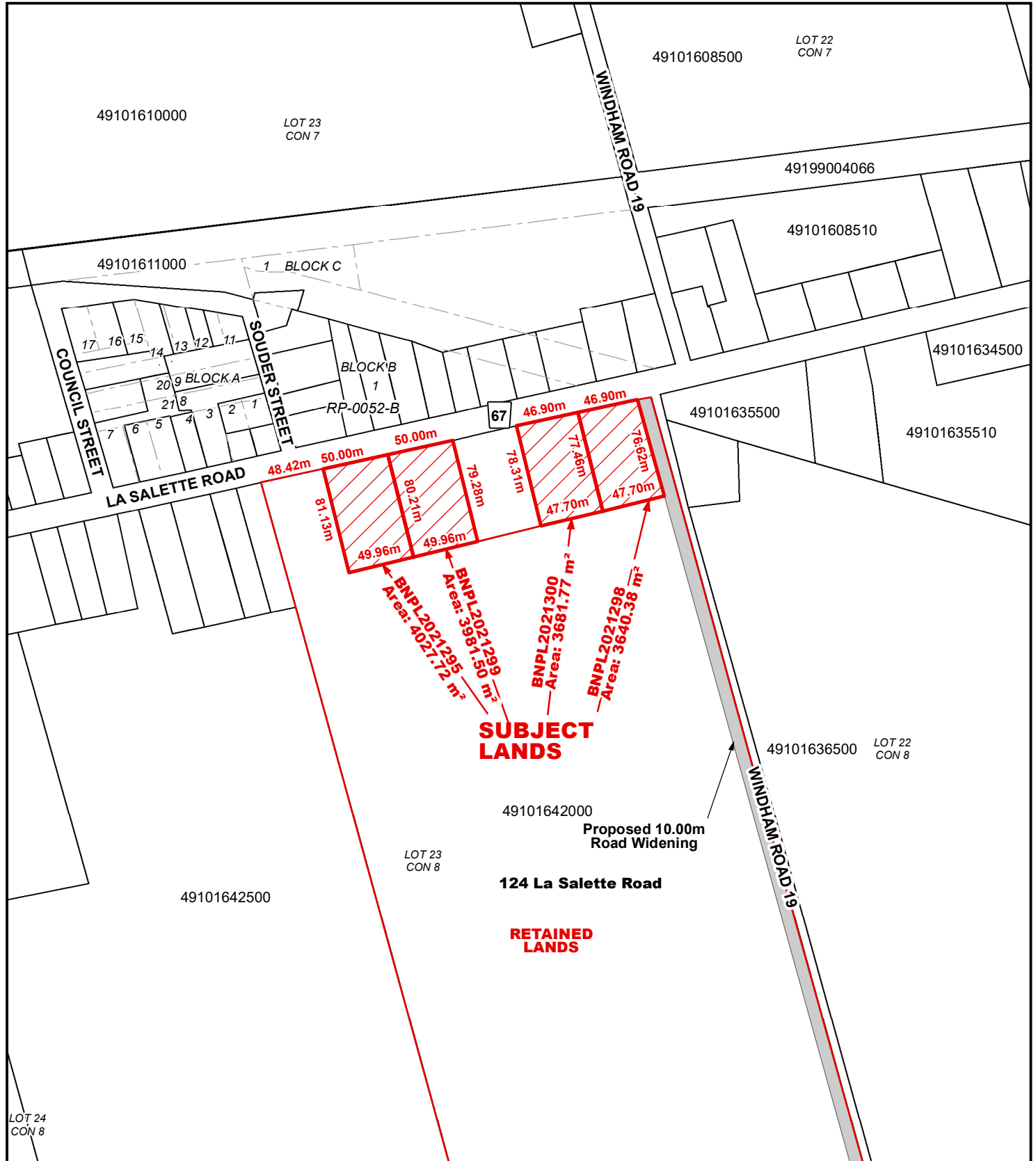
