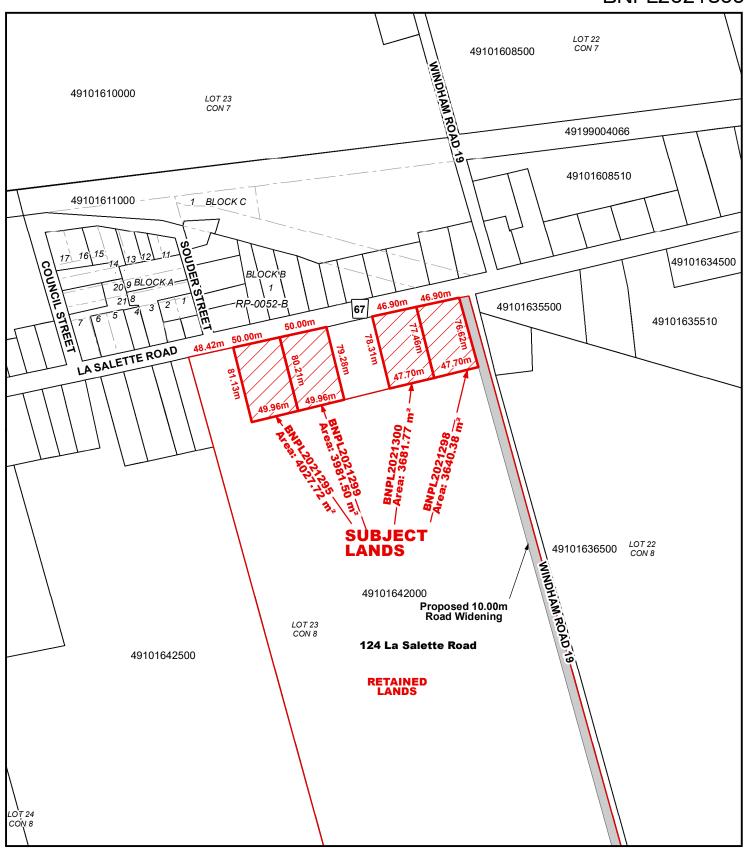


LOCATION OF LANDS AFFECTED

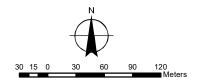
