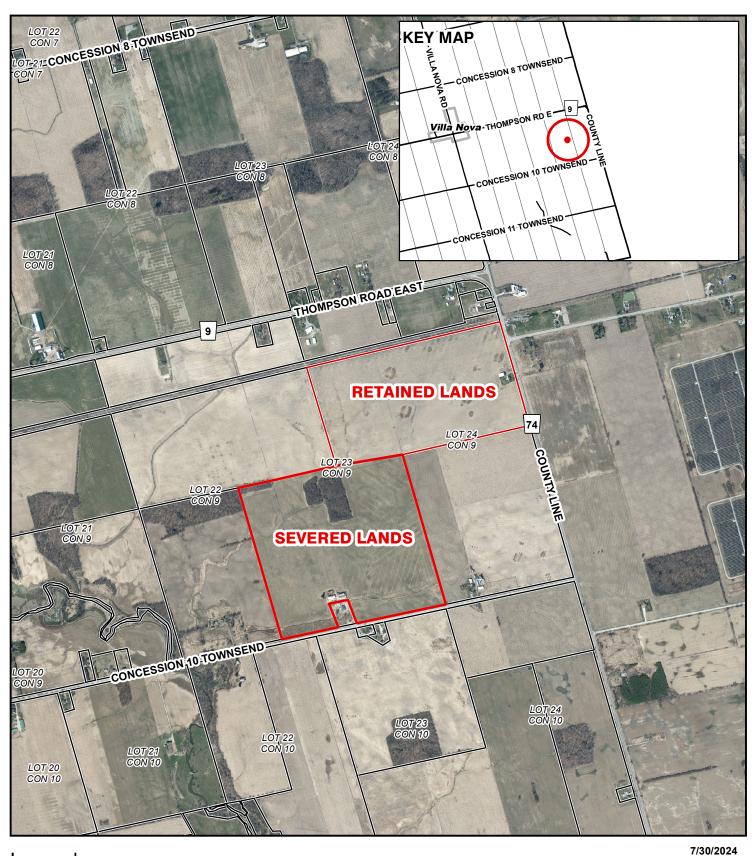






CONTEXT MAP

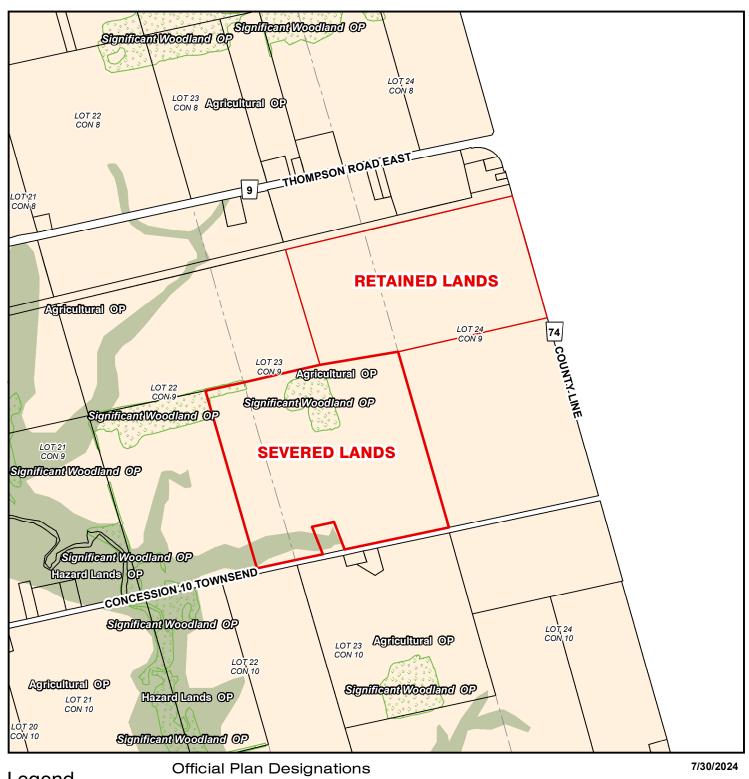

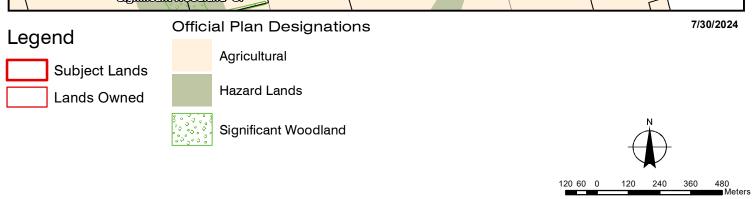

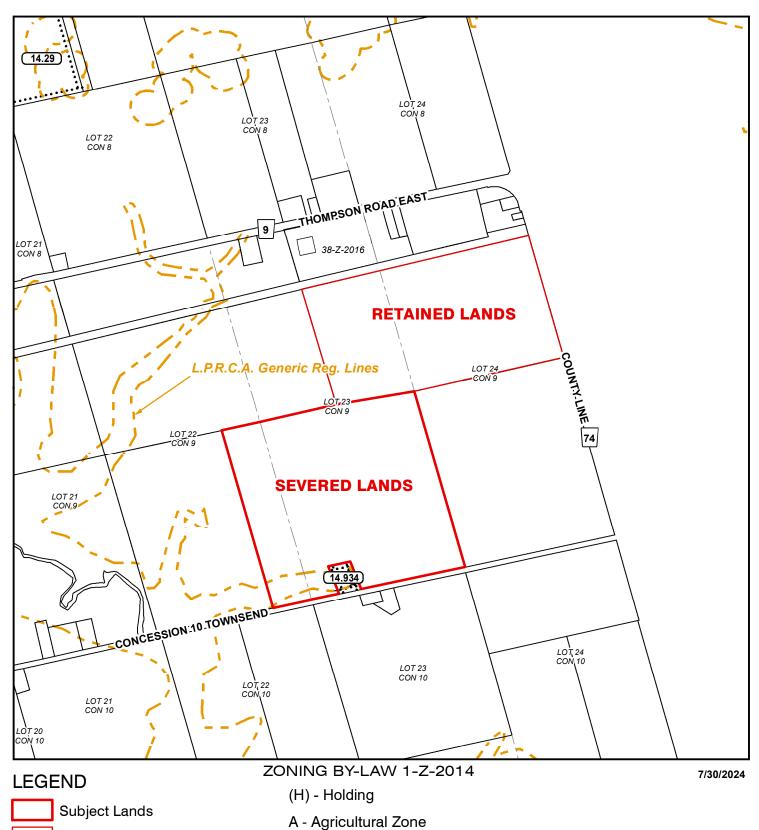
MAP B

OFFICIAL PLAN MAP



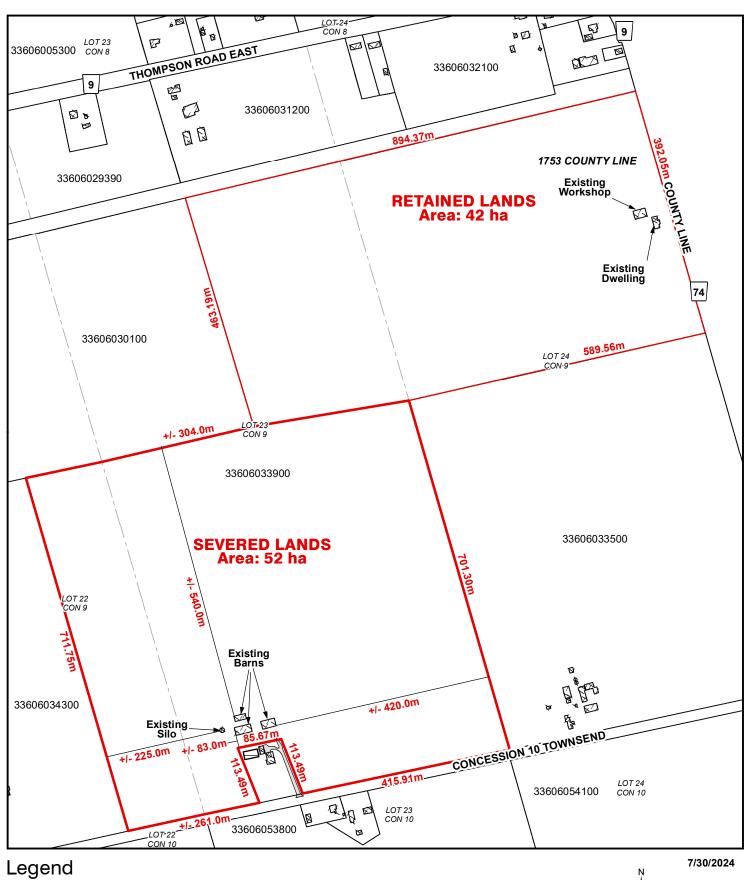


MAP C ZONING BY-LAW MAP

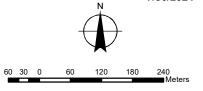
