As per Section 11.2 in the Norfolk County Zoning By-law 1-Z-2014  
“Notwithstanding Subsection 1.4.2, the extent of the Hazard Land Zone (HL)  
shown on the Zoning Maps may be revised on a site specific basis where  
initiated by the land owner without amendment to this By-law where such  
revision is determined to be in acceptable to and confirmed in writing by the  
Conservation Authority having jurisdiction”.

Property owner Mike Heirwegh inquired about building a garage in the rear of his  
property at 67 Ordnance Ave in Turkey Point as attached. The lands are  
currently zoned HL.

As per the attached e-mail from LPRCA dated August 13, 2015 they are in  
agreement to revising the HL to accommodate this request as outlined on the  
attached drawing.

This memo is for the purpose of the property owner to identify that Norfolk  
County has altered the zoning as requested in compliance with all other  
provisions of the Resort Residential Zone.

This memo is also to further inform the Building Division of this amendment and also provide the GIS Division with the information to change during the next available Zoning By-law update.
