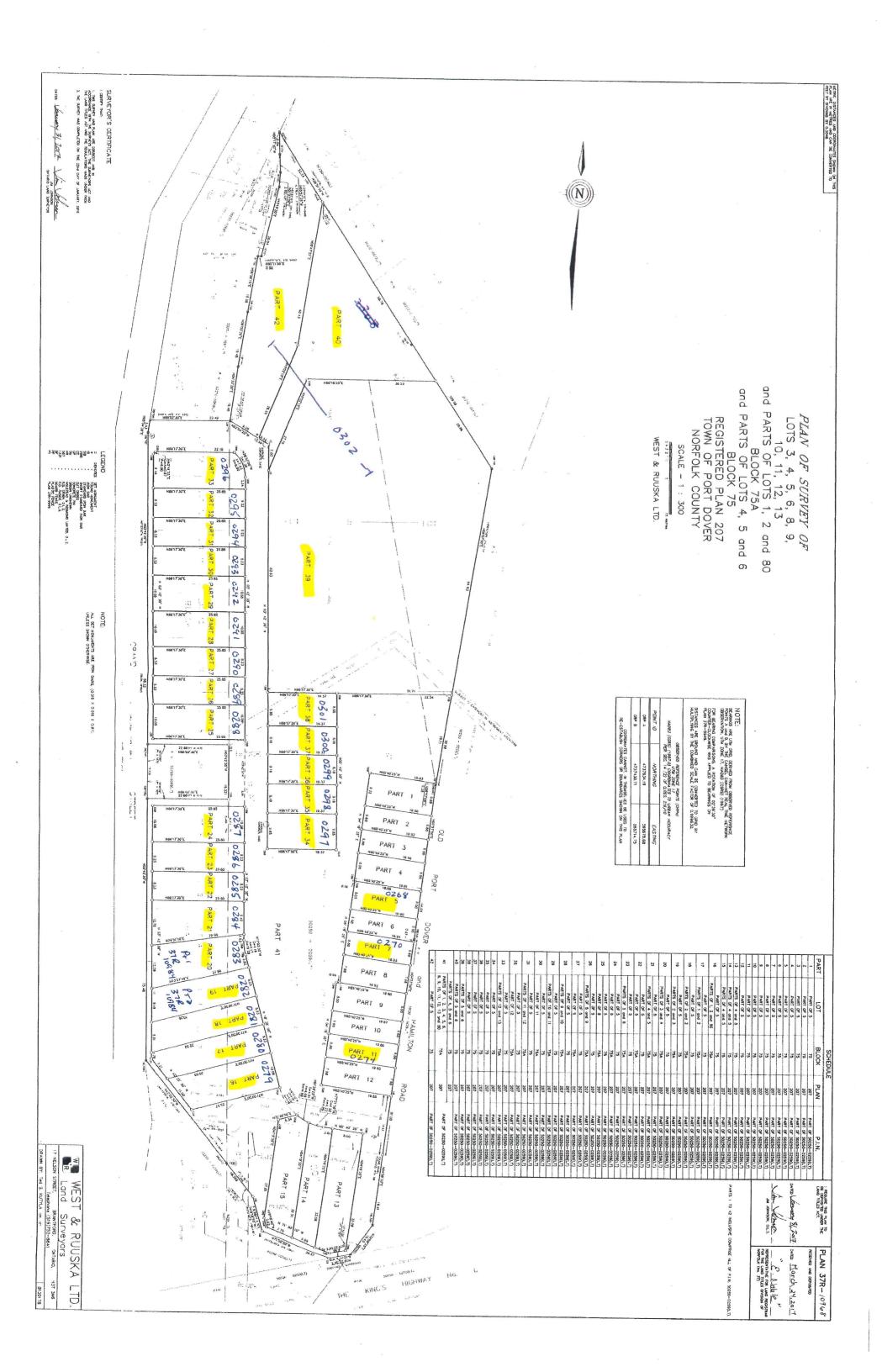

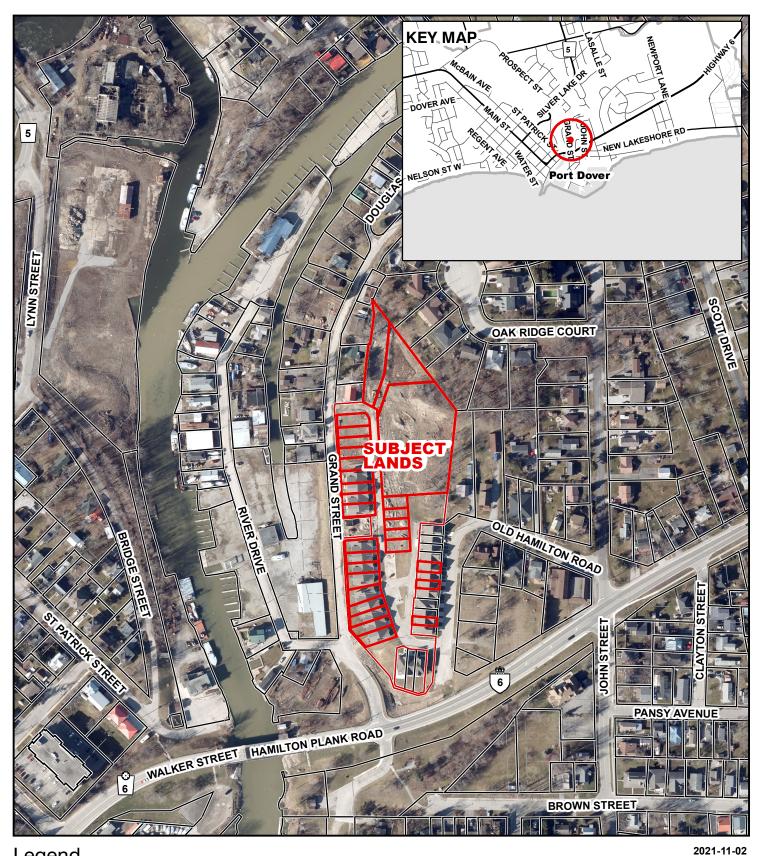

Urban Area of PORT DOVER

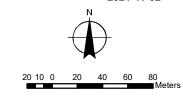

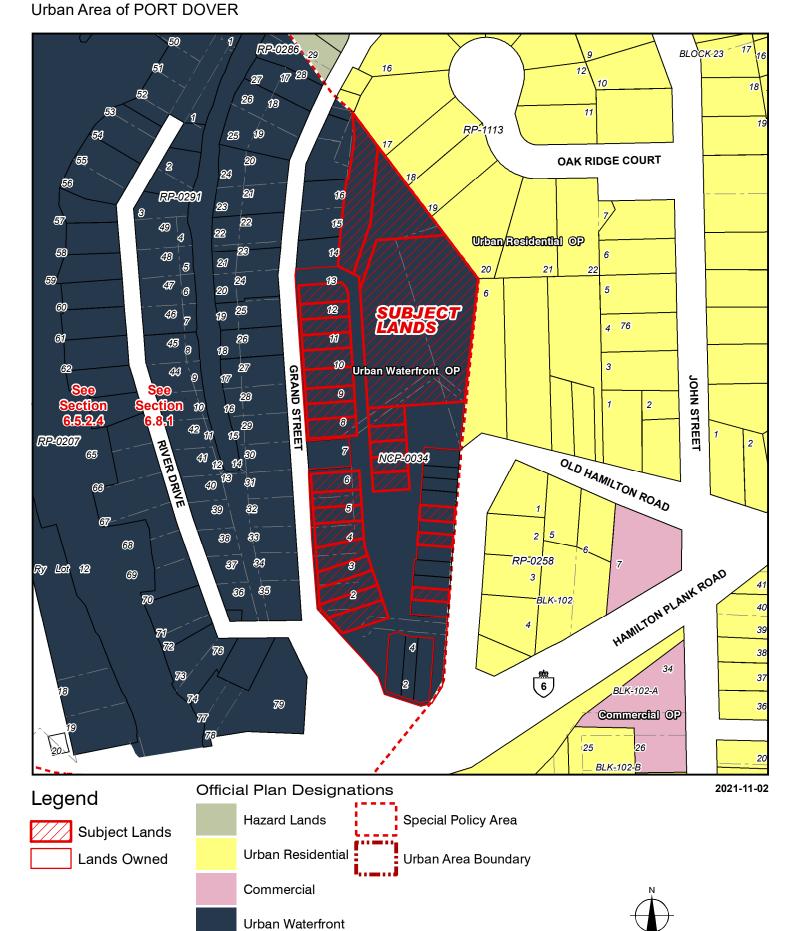

MAP B OFFICIAL PLAN MAP

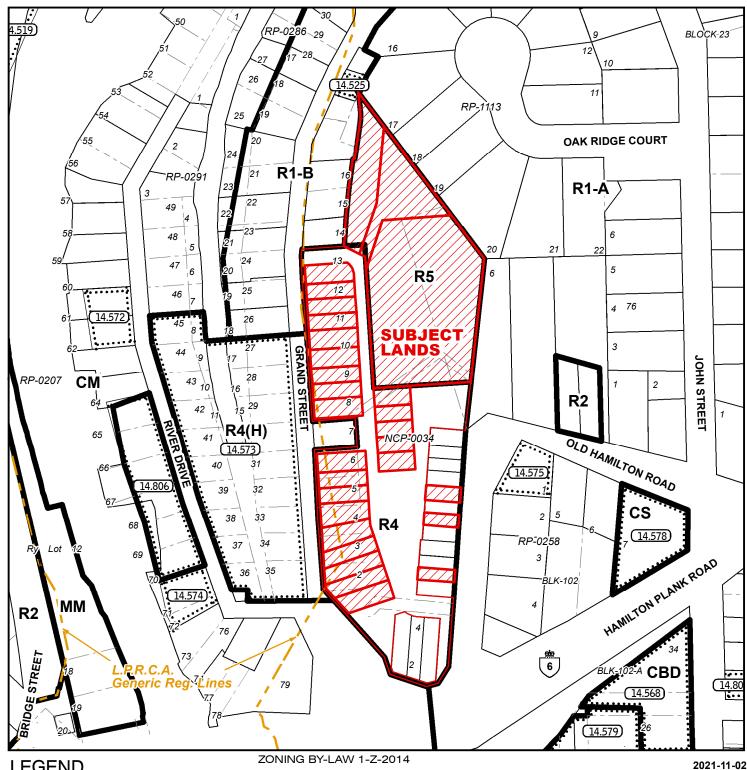

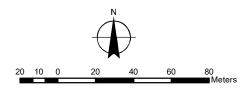
