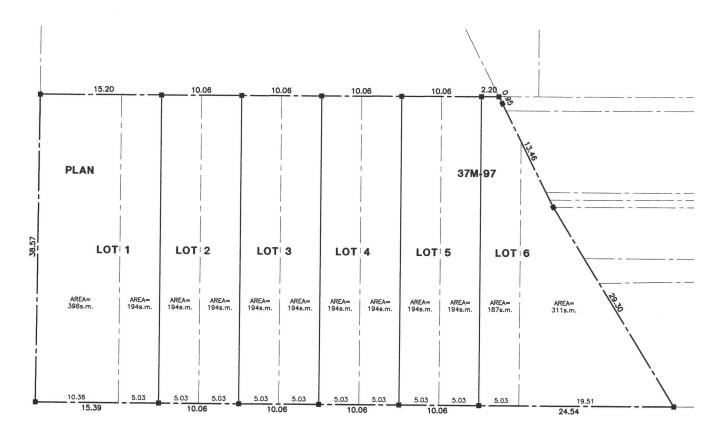

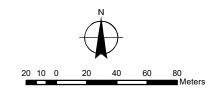
Urban Area of SIMCOE

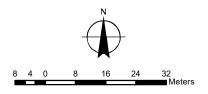


MAP B OFFICIAL PLAN MAP

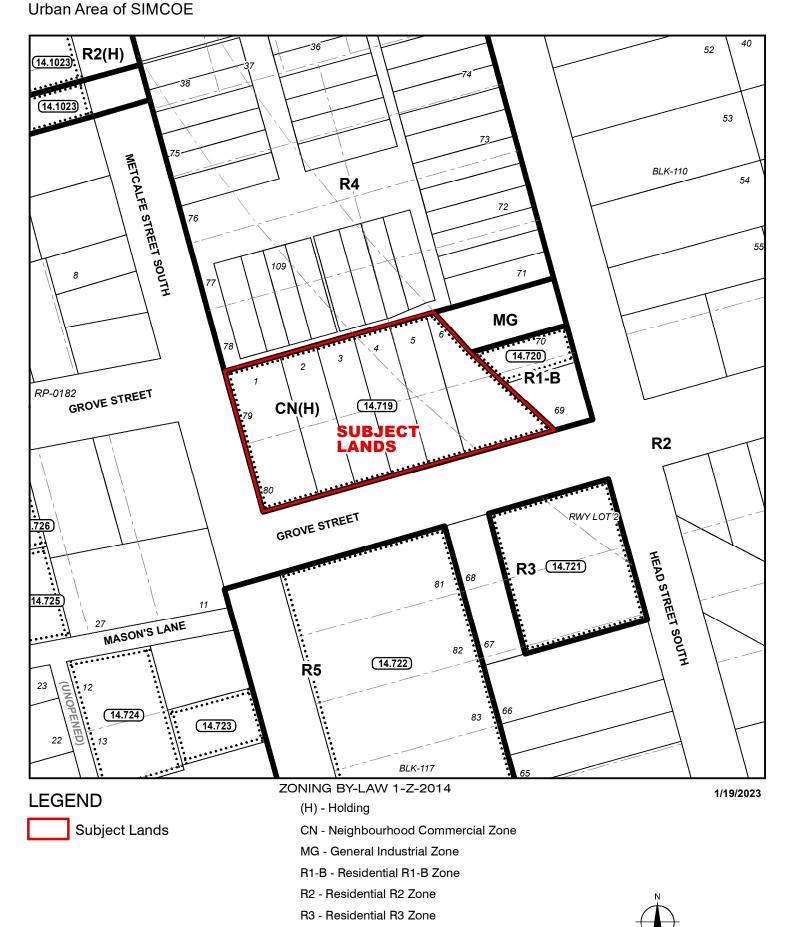
Urban Area of SIMCOE
