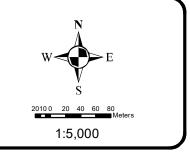

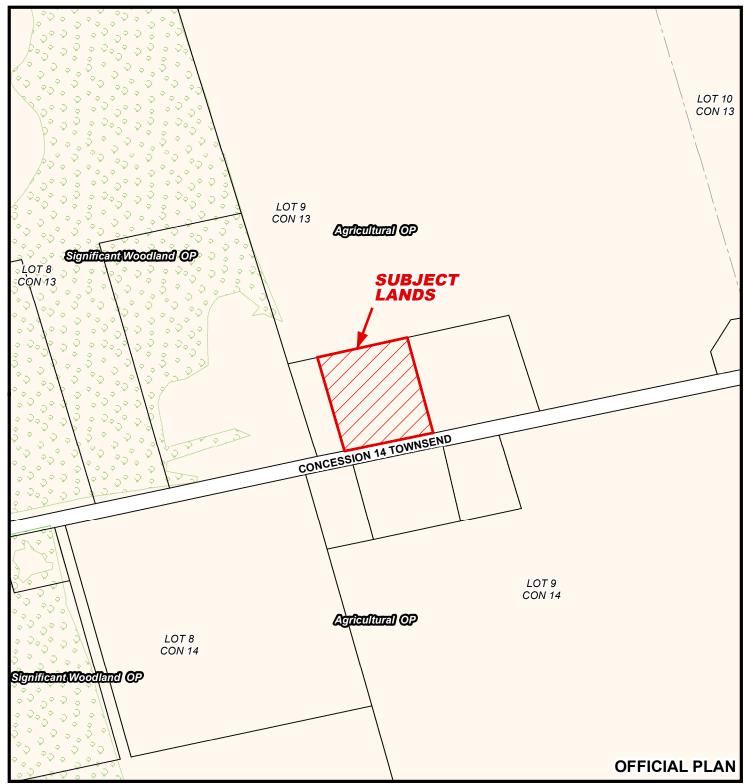






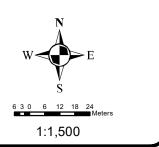
MAP 2
