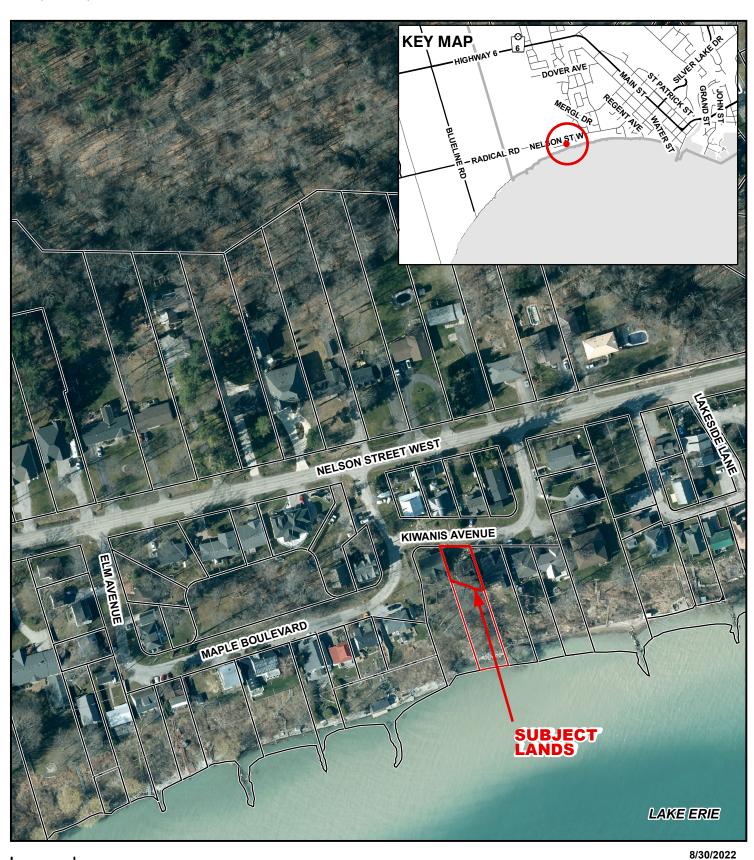

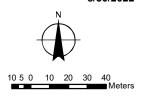


MAP A CONTEXT MAP Urban Area of PORT DOVER



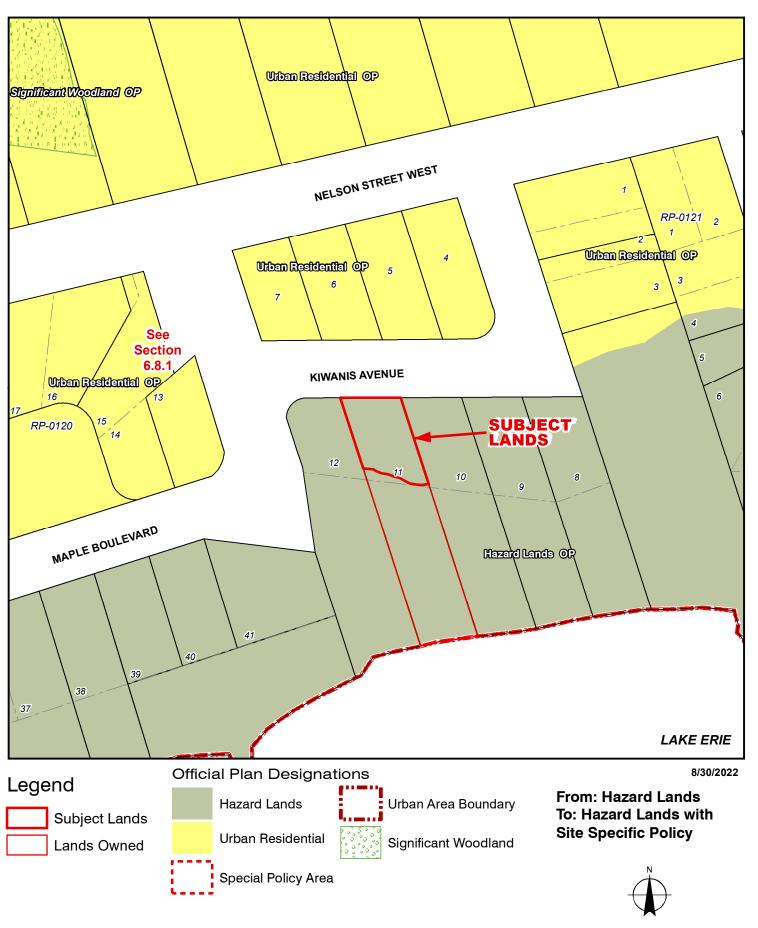

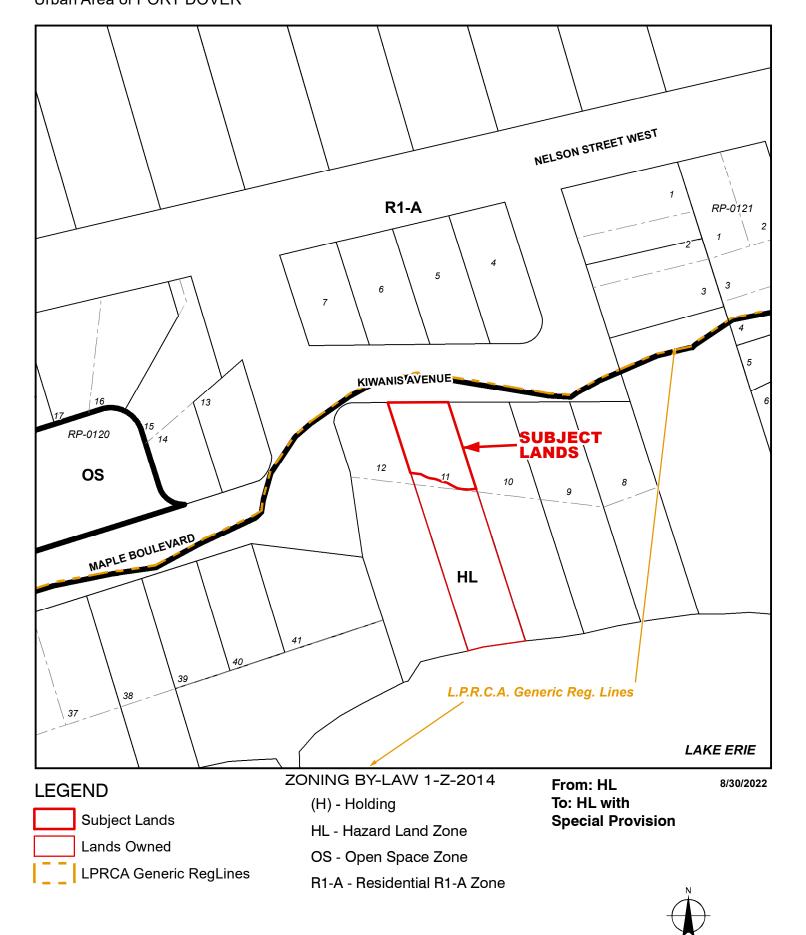


MAP BPROPOSED OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT MAP
