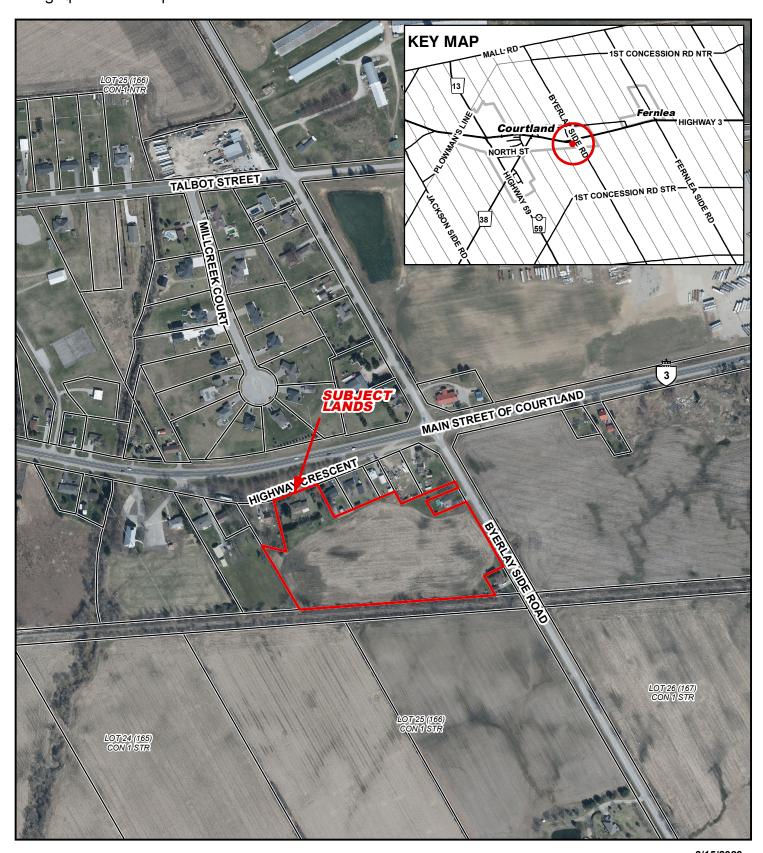

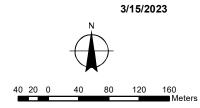


MAP A CONTEXT MAP Geographic Township of MIDDLETON



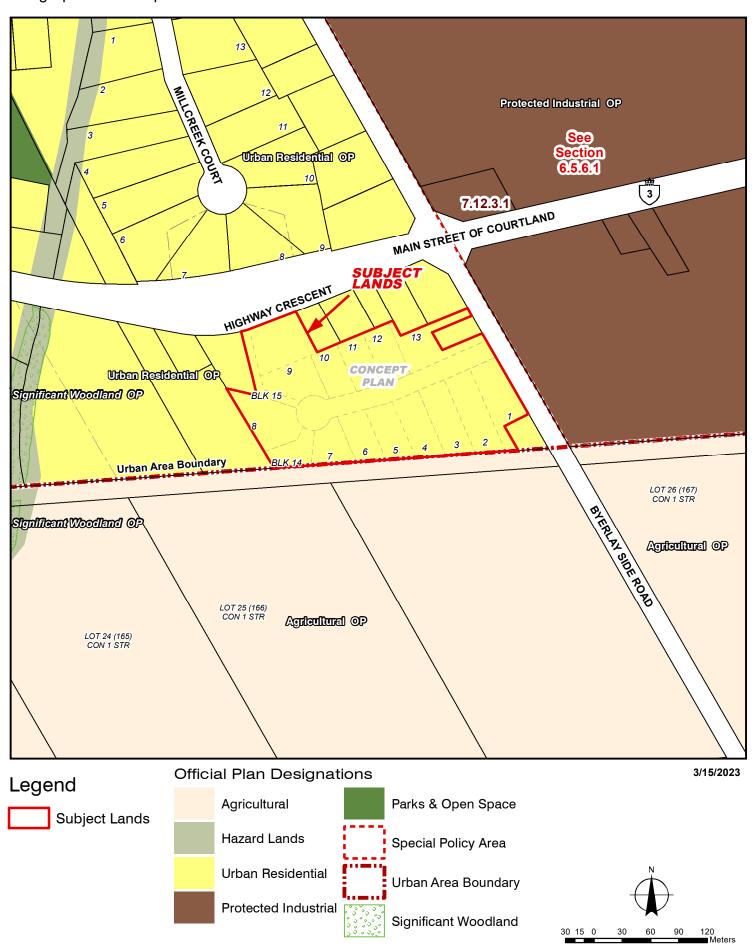

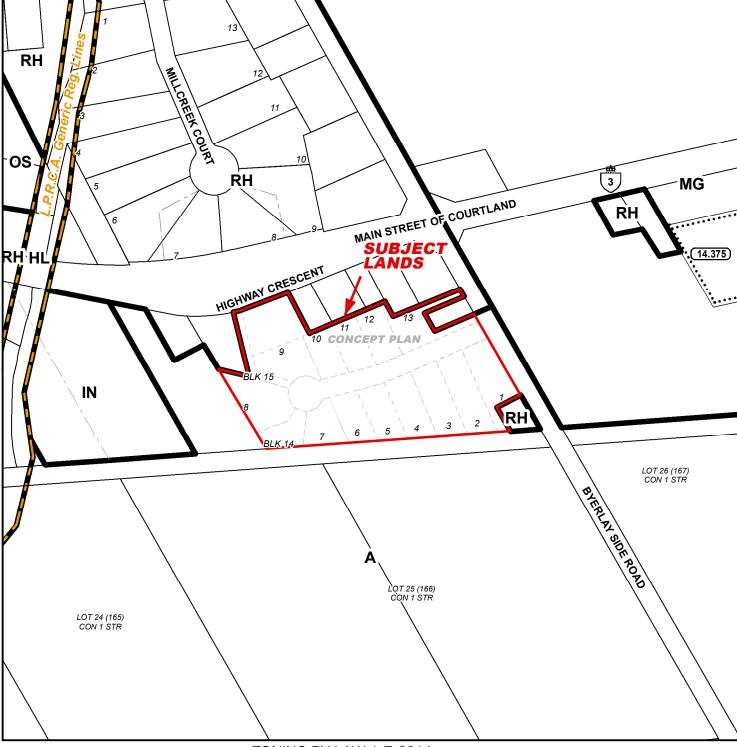


MAP B OFFICIAL PLAN MAP

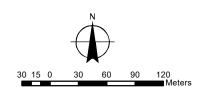
