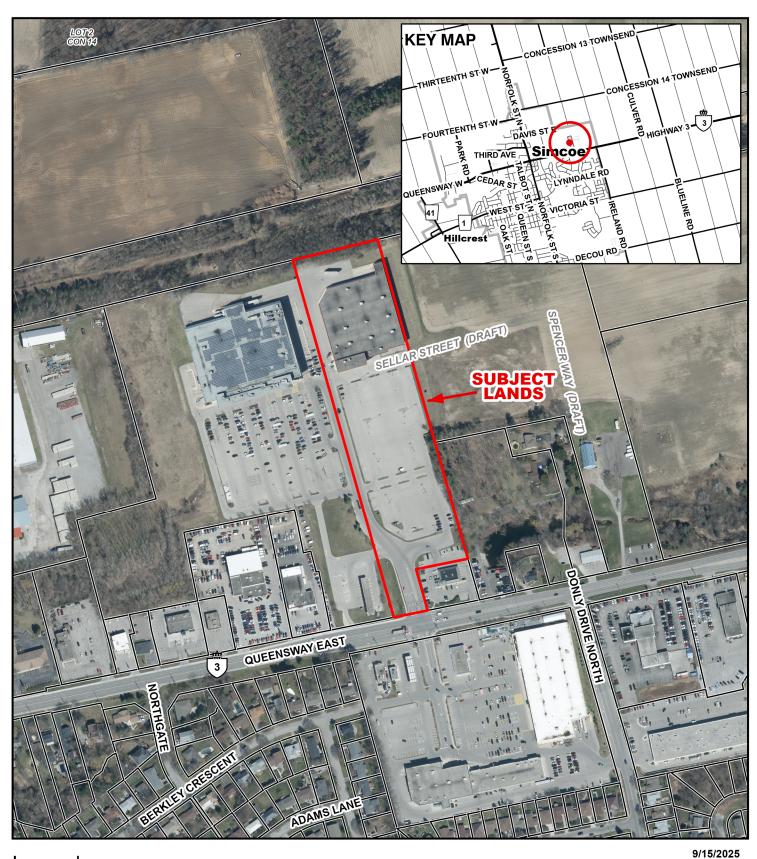

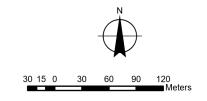

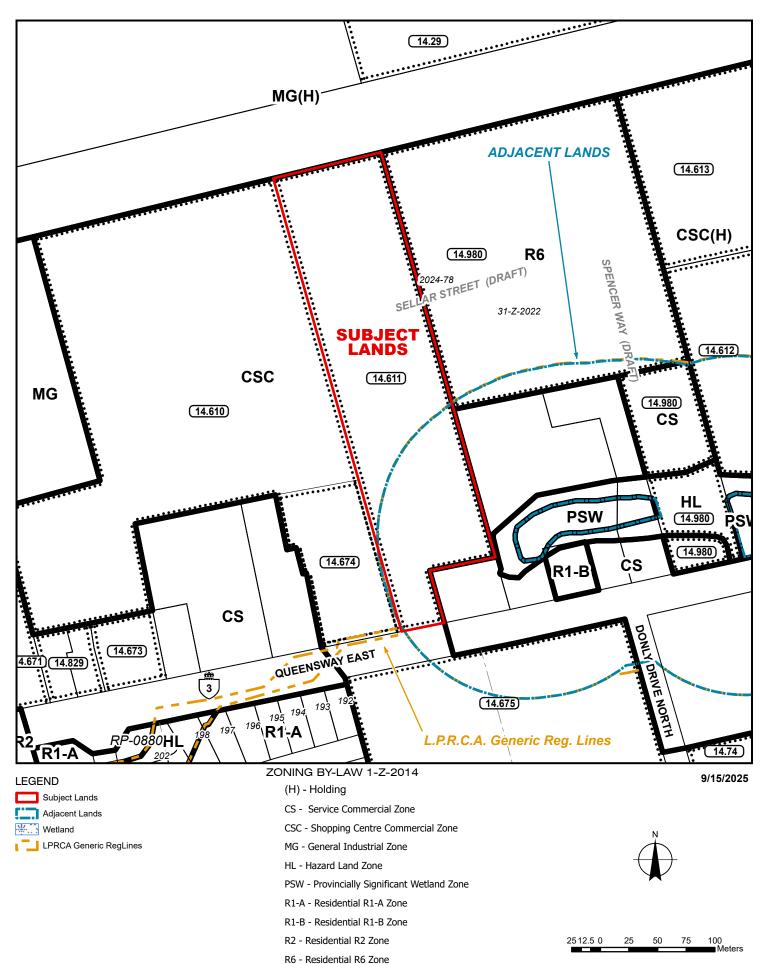
MAP B OFFICIAL PLAN MAP





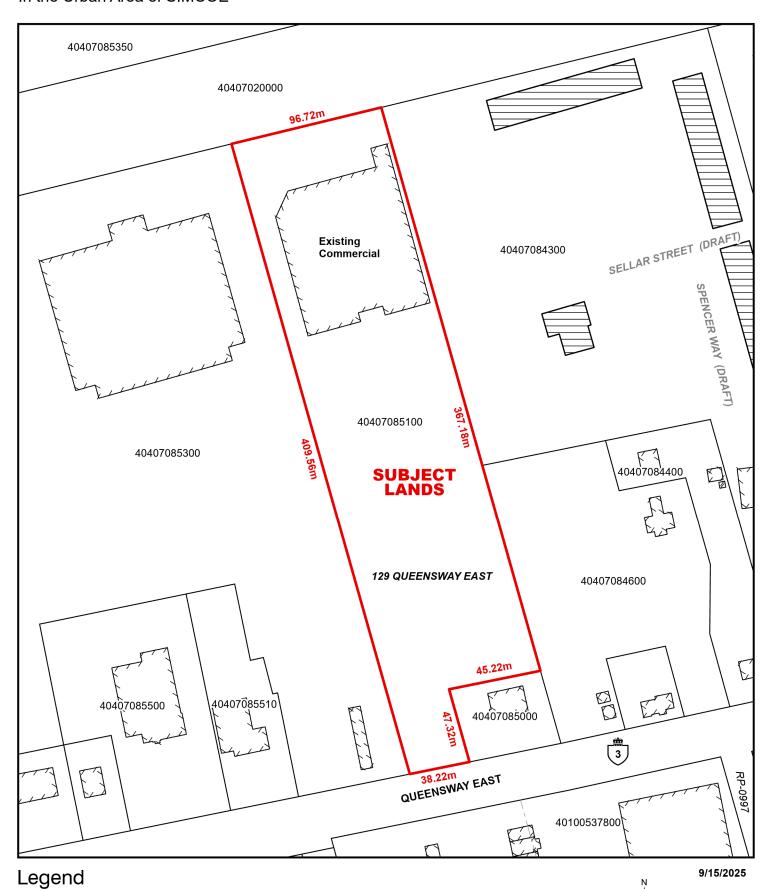
PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT MAP

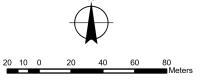


CONCEPTUAL PLAN

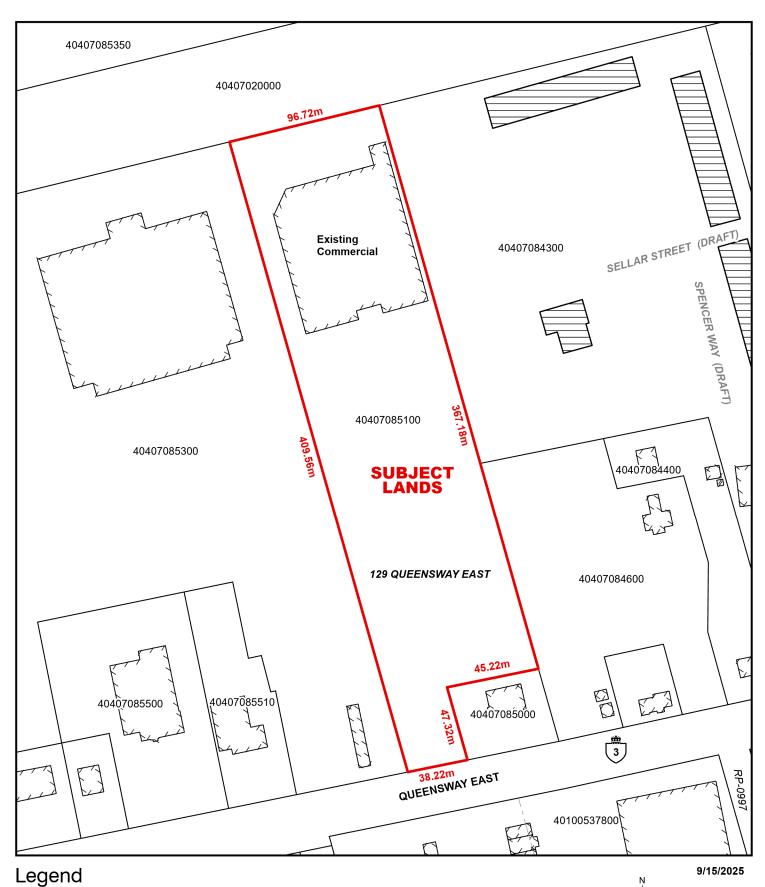
